I-10 Both Directions

The left lane in both directions on I-10 will be closed between the Buena Vista Bridge (aka the Bridge to Nowhere) and the Asarco Bridge (located east of the Executive Center Overpass). The closure will be in place during the day time for five days:

- > 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday, **May 23**
- > 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday, **May 24**
- > 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday, **May 25**
- > 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday, **May 26**
- > 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Friday, **May 27**

Crews will be repairing the damaged rail along the median of I-10 to prepare for more extensive work coming to that section of I-10. Read more about the coming work at <http://bit.ly/TimSays2>.

Mesa

The Mesa Entrance Ramp to I-10 West and the left lane on North Desert Boulevard, from the Mesa Entrance Ramp to Thorn Avenue, will be closed during the day time for two days:

- > 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday, **May 23**
- > 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday, **May 24**

Crews will be working on fiber cables.

REMINDER: McClintock Drive is closed at the South Desert Boulevard intersection until further notice.

All work is dependent upon weather conditions.

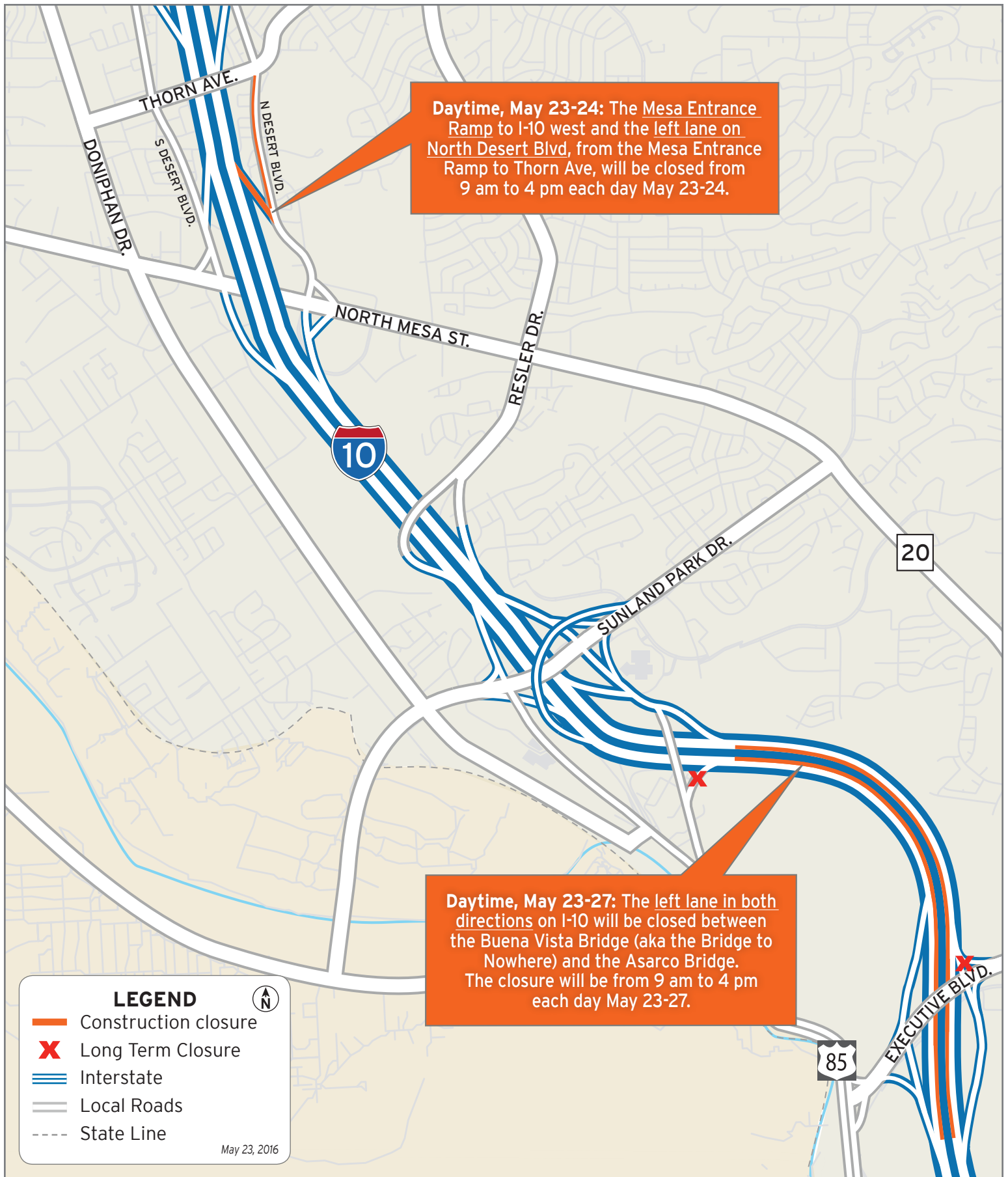
