Closures at Mesa and I-10 will continue Tuesday due to vehicular collision

The following closures planned for Monday, May 9, will have to carry over to Tuesday, May 10, due to a nearby vehicular collision. The collision disrupted work plans in the intersection, resulting in May 9's closures to continue as follows:

Mesa

Several closures will be in place at Mesa and I-10 during the day from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. **Tuesday, May 10:**

- > The Mesa Exit Ramp (Exit 11) from eastbound I-10
- > The right lane on North Mesa Street (SH 20) between North and South Desert Boulevard (in the direction headed toward Doniphan Drive)

Crews will be moving barrier walls and re-striping lanes in order to complete the shift of traffic onto the new, recently completed lanes on South Desert Boulevard. This closure is scheduled in avoidance of the morning and afternoon rush hours.

I-10 Eastbound

The right lane on I-10 eastbound between the Thorn Overpass and the Mesa Exit Ramp (Exit 11) will be closed during the day from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. **Tuesday, May 10.** Crews will be moving barrier walls on the shoulder of I-10 to continue the shift of traffic lanes on South Desert Boulevard. This closure is scheduled in avoidance of the morning and afternoon rush hours.

Follow detour signs in place.
All work is dependent upon weather conditions.

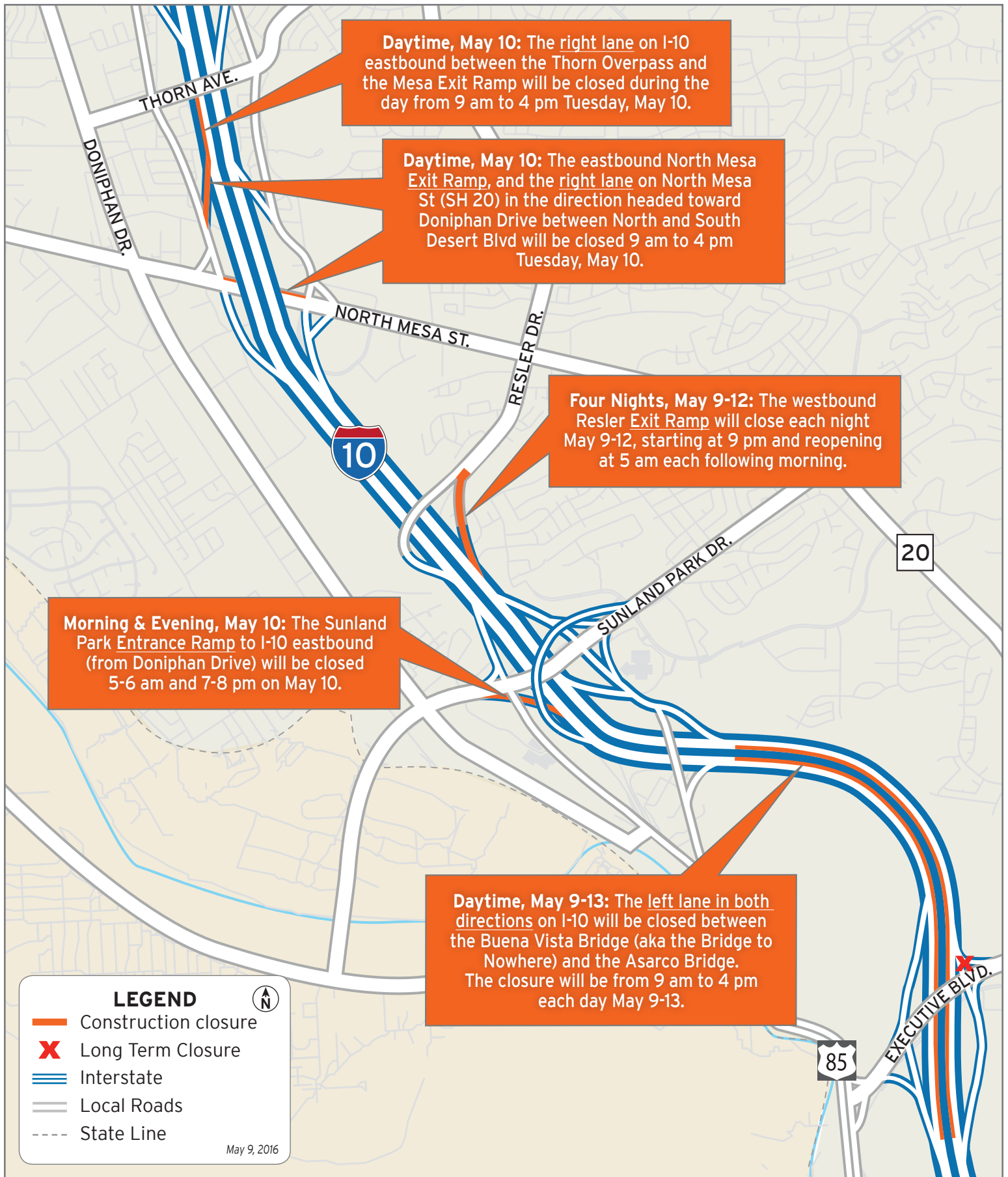
