Mesa

- The eastbound North Mesa Exit Ramp as well as the South Desert Boulevard frontage road up to the Mesa Intersection will be closed for one night from 9 p.m. **Monday, April 11**, to 5 a.m. the following morning. Crews will be pouring deck.
- The intersection at I-10 and North Mesa Street (SH 20) will be subject to various and intermittently changing lane closures for two nights. Crews will be setting up temporary traffic signals.
 - > 9 p.m. **Monday, April 11**, to 5 a.m. the following morning
 - > 9 p.m. **Tuesday, April 12**, to 5 a.m. the following morning

Sunland

The eastbound Sunland Park Exit Ramp will be closed for one night from 9 p.m. **Wednesday, April 13** to 5 a.m. the following morning. Crews will be trenching and installing electrical ground boxes.

I-10 Eastbound/Westbound

- Between the Buena Vista Bridge (aka the Bridge to Nowhere) and Executive Center Boulevard, the inside shoulder and left lane on I-10 eastbound will be closed for two nights:
 - > 9 p.m. **Monday, April 11** to 5 a.m. the following morning
 - > 9 p.m. **Tuesday, April 12** to 5 a.m. the following morningCrews will be drilling into the median of I-10 to locate fiber and electrical components.
- At Executive Center, the inside shoulder and left lane on I-10 westbound will be closed for two nights:
 - > 9 p.m. **Monday, April 11** to 5 a.m. the following morning
 - > 9 p.m. **Tuesday, April 12** to 5 a.m. the following morningCrews will be drilling into the median of I-10 to locate fiber and electrical components.
- Between the Buena Vista Bridge (aka the Bridge to Nowhere) and Executive Center Boulevard, the right lane on I-10 eastbound will be closed during the day for two days.
 - > 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. **Tuesday, April 12**
 - > 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. **Wednesday, April 13**Crews will be pouring deck. The closure must stay in place while the concrete hardens.

All work is dependent upon weather conditions.

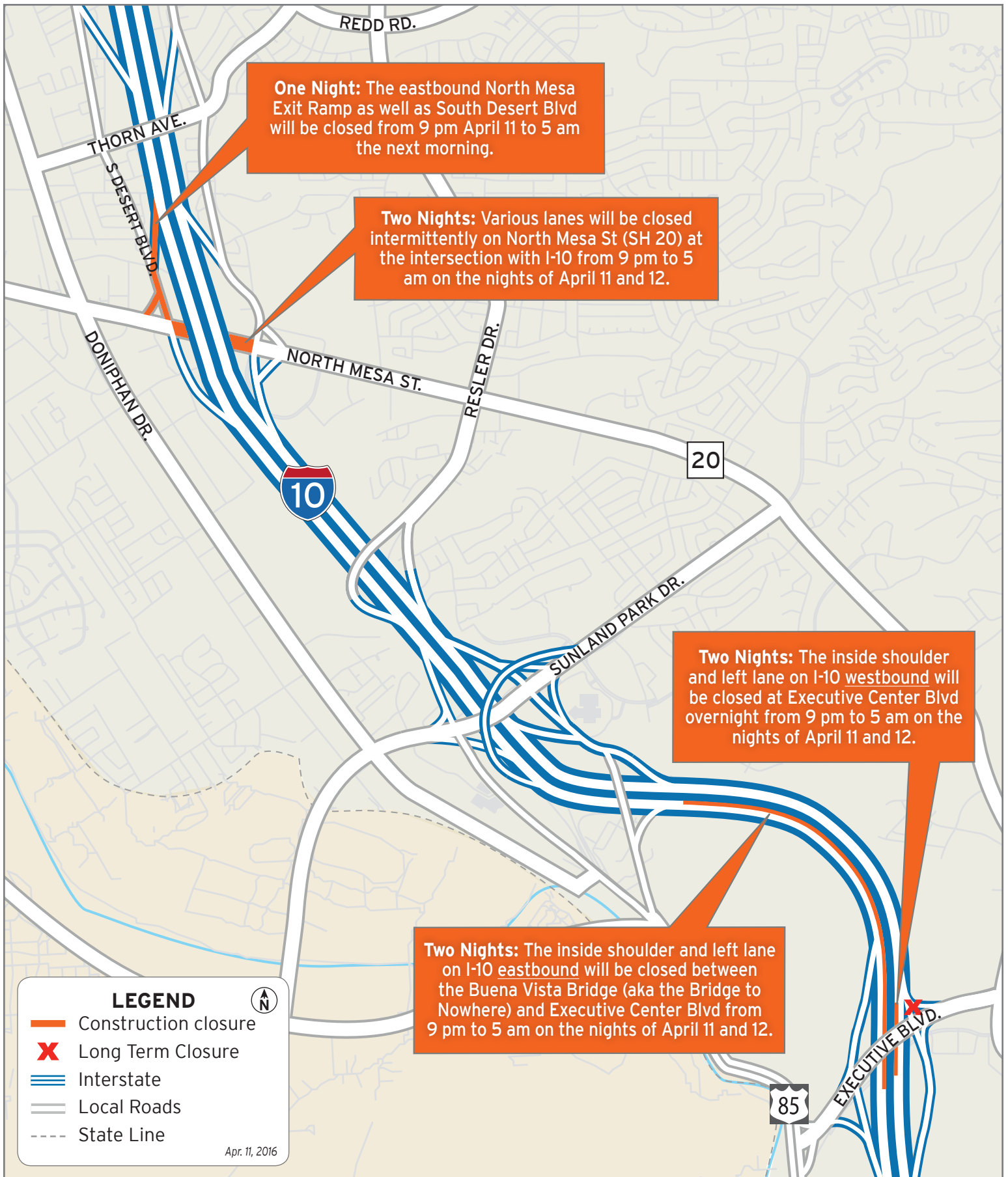
