Sunland Park

Overnight from 9 p.m. Sunday, March 13 to 5 a.m. the following morning

I-10 westbound will be reduced to one lane for approximately one mile on the approach to Sunland Park Drive. Crews will be placing concrete barrier.

Overnight from 9 p.m. Monday, March 14 to 5 a.m. the following morning

I-10 eastbound will be reduced to one lane for approximately one mile between Sunland Park Drive and the Buena Vista Bridge (also known as the "Bridge to Nowhere"). Crews will be placing concrete barrier.

Paisano Drive (US 85)

Paisano Drive (US 85) westbound where it bridges over I-10 and joins with the exit ramp for Sunland Park Drive will be reduced to one lane for four nights. Additionally, the entrance ramp from Paisano Drive (US 85) onto I-10 westbound will be completely closed during the same four nights:

- 9 p.m. Monday, March 14 to 5 a.m. the following morning
- 9 p.m. Tuesday, March 15 to 5 a.m. the following morning
- 9 p.m. Wednesday, March 16 to 5 a.m. the following morning
- 9 p.m. Thursday, March 17 to 5 a.m. the following morning

The closures are necessary to protect workers as they haul dirt.

North Mesa

From 9 p.m. Wednesday, March 16 to 4 p.m. Thursday, March 17

The North Mesa exit ramp on I-10 eastbound as well as the South Desert Boulevard frontage road up to North Mesa Street will be completely closed so crews may install bridge beams.

Notice: This closure will impact rush hour on the morning of March 17. Drivers are encouraged to plan ahead (i.e. use an alternate route adjust travel time to avoid the rush hour etc.).

All work is dependent upon weather conditions.

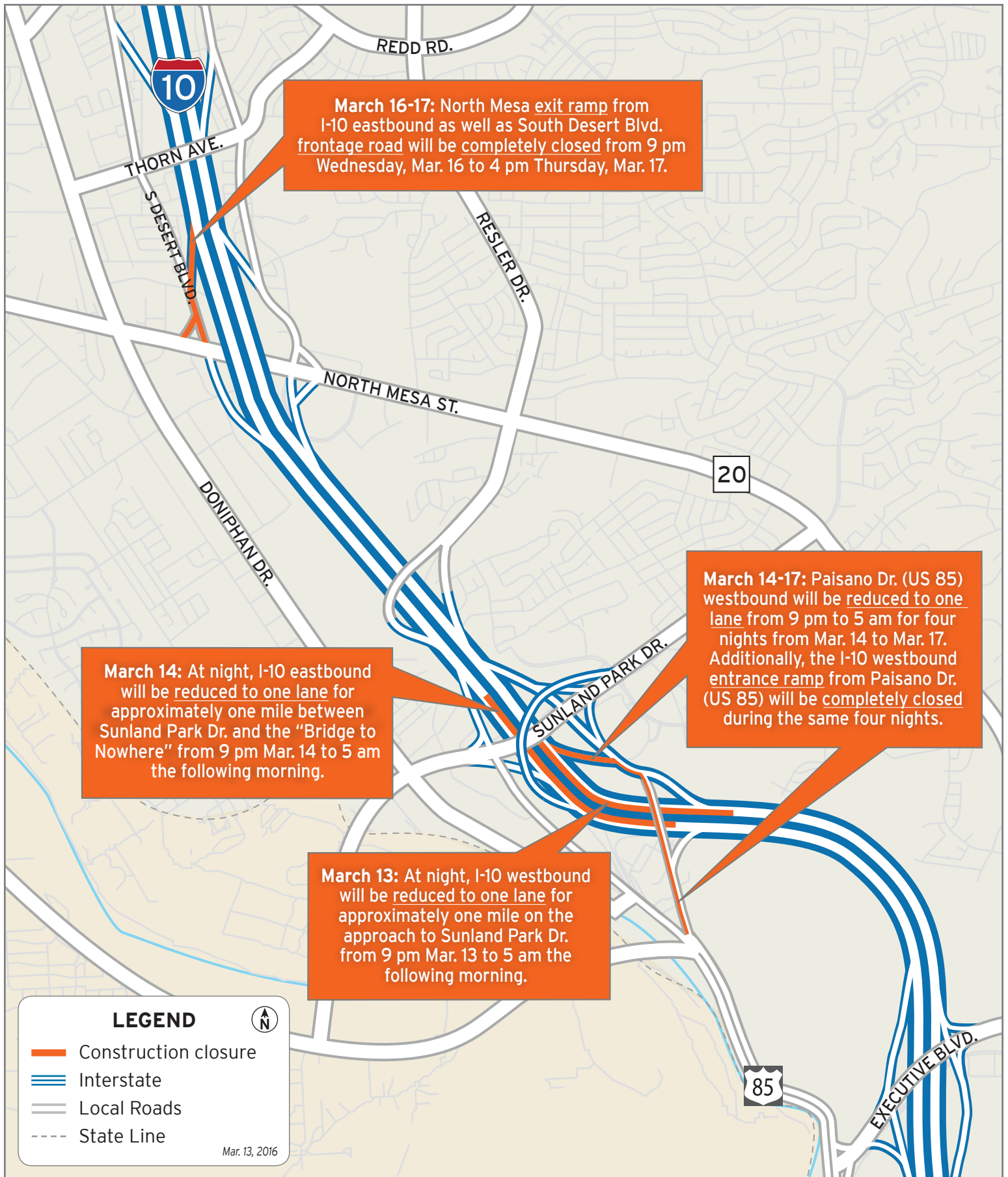
