Paisano Drive (US 85)

Paisano Drive (US 85) westbound where it bridges over I-10 near Sunland Park Drive will be reduced to one lane for four nights. During the same period, the entrance ramp from Paisano Drive (US 85) onto I-10 westbound will be closed.

Night One: 9 p.m. Monday, March 28 to 5 a.m. the following morning

Night Two: 9 p.m. Tuesday, March 29 to 5 a.m. the following morning

Night Three: 9 p.m. Wednesday, March 30 to 5 a.m. the following morning

Night Four: 9 p.m. Thursday, March 31 to 5 a.m. the following morning

The closures are necessary while crews haul dirt.

Resler

The exit ramp to Resler Drive from I-10 westbound will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. Tuesday, March 29 to 5 a.m. the following morning. The closure is necessary while crews form electrical ground boxes.

Sunland Park

The exit ramp to Sunland Park Drive from I-10 eastbound will be closed overnight from 9 p.m. Wednesday, March 30 to 5 a.m. the following morning. The closure is necessary while crews bore underground.

All work is dependent upon weather conditions.

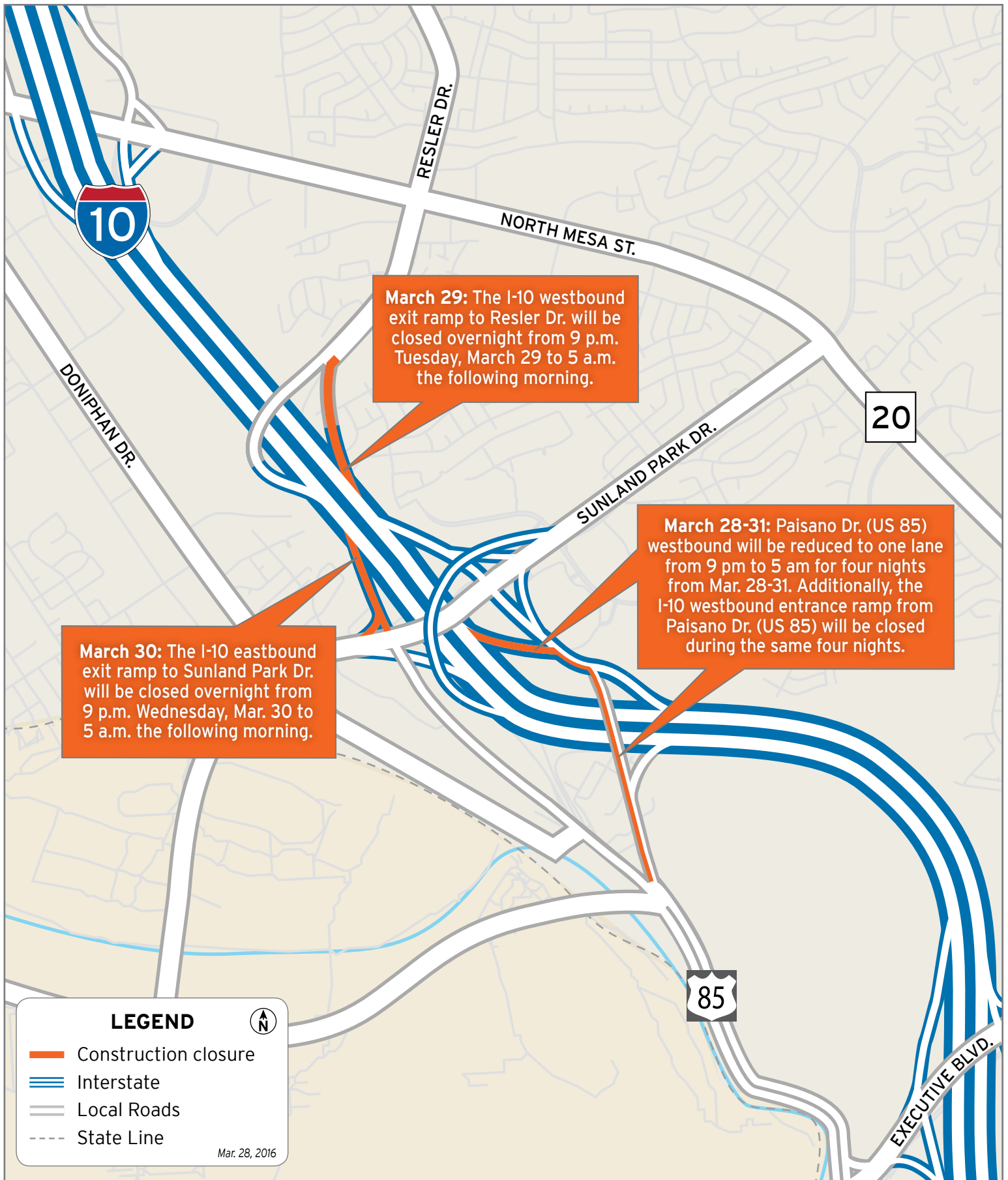
