I-10 • Resler to North Mesa

I-10 westbound between Resler Drive and North Mesa Street will be down to one lane for four nights:

- 9 p.m. Sunday, March 6 to 5 a.m. the following morning
- 9 p.m. Monday, March 7 to 5 a.m. the following morning
- 9 p.m. Wednesday, March 9 to 5 a.m. the following morning
- 9 p.m. Thursday, March 10 to 5 a.m. the following morning

Crews will be placing concrete barrier and re-stripping lanes.

Sunland Park

The Sunland Park Drive exit ramp from I-10 eastbound will be completely closed for two nights:

- 9 p.m. Monday, March 7 to 5 a.m. the following morning
- 9 p.m. Tuesday, March 8 to 5 a.m. the following morning

Crews will be placing concrete barrier and re-stripping lanes.

North Mesa

The North Mesa exit ramp from I-10 westbound will be completely closed for three hours while crews re-stripe lanes:

- 5 a.m. to 8 a.m. Saturday, March 5

Four lanes will be reduced to three on North Mesa Street where it passes underneath I-10 in the direction headed toward Doniphan Drive. This right-hand lane closure will happen during the day so crews may install new concrete drainage pipes:

- 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday, March 7

North Mesa exit ramp from I-10 eastbound as well as South Desert Boulevard (eastbound) frontage road that leads to the North Mesa Street intersection will be completely closed so crews may install bridge beams:

- 9 p.m. Wednesday, March 16 to 4 p.m. Thursday, March 17.

Notice: This closure will impact the morning rush hour on March 17. Drivers are encouraged to plan ahead (i.e. use an alternate route, adjust travel time to avoid the rush hour, etc.).

I-10 • Executive to Buena Vista

I-10 in both directions between Executive Center Boulevard and the Buena Vista Bridge (aka the Bridge to Nowhere) will be reduced from three lanes to two:

- 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday, March 9
- 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday, March 10

The lane reduction is necessary while crews install bridge beams.

Courtesy Reminder:

El Paso Electric has announced it will close I-10 in both directions on March 6 from 3 a.m. to 3 p.m. between Sunland Park Drive and Executive Center Blvd. El Paso Electric crews will work to remove two transmission structures between Sunland Park Drive and Paisano Drive, install new structures on both sides of I-10, and replace existing wire. 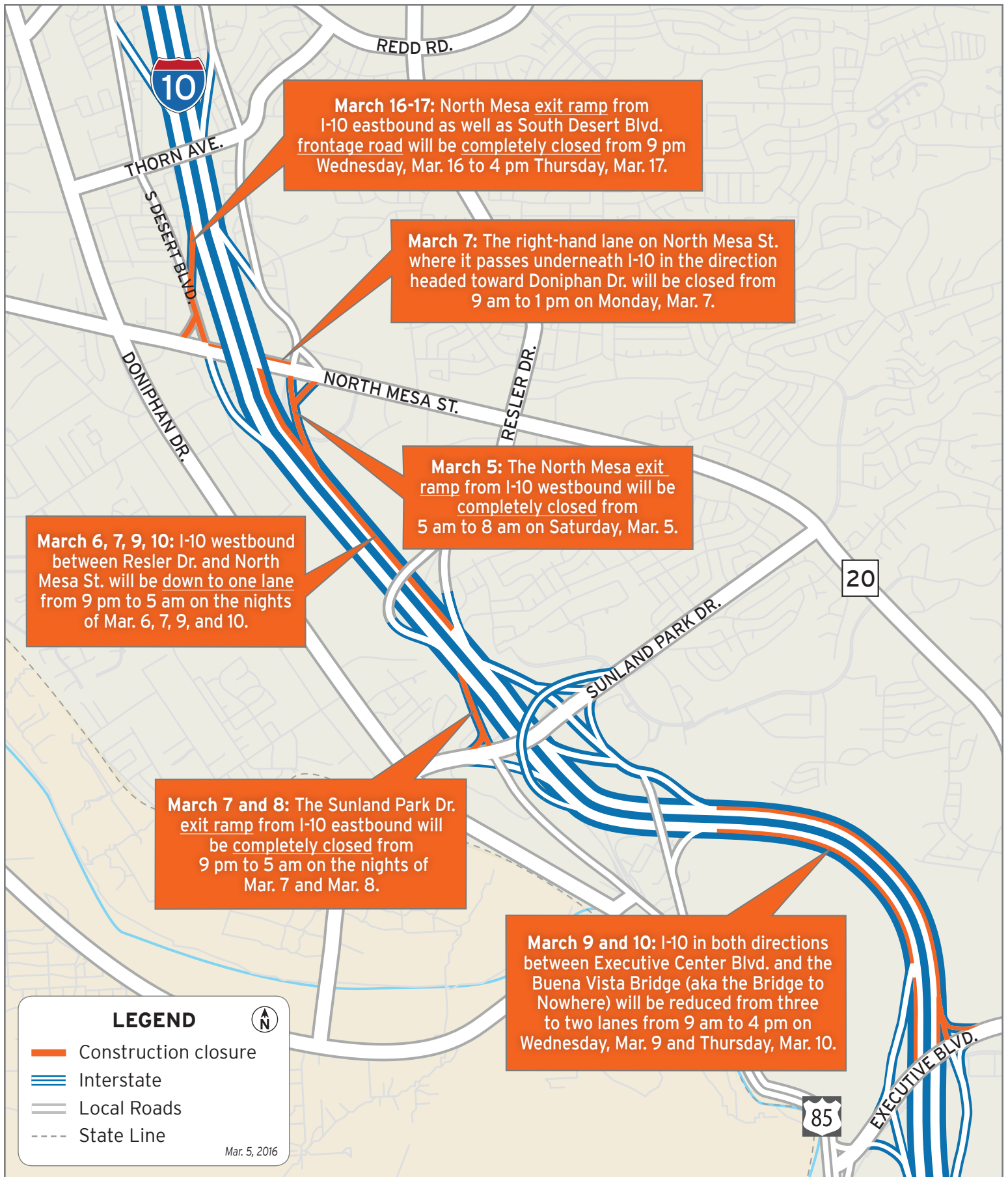
