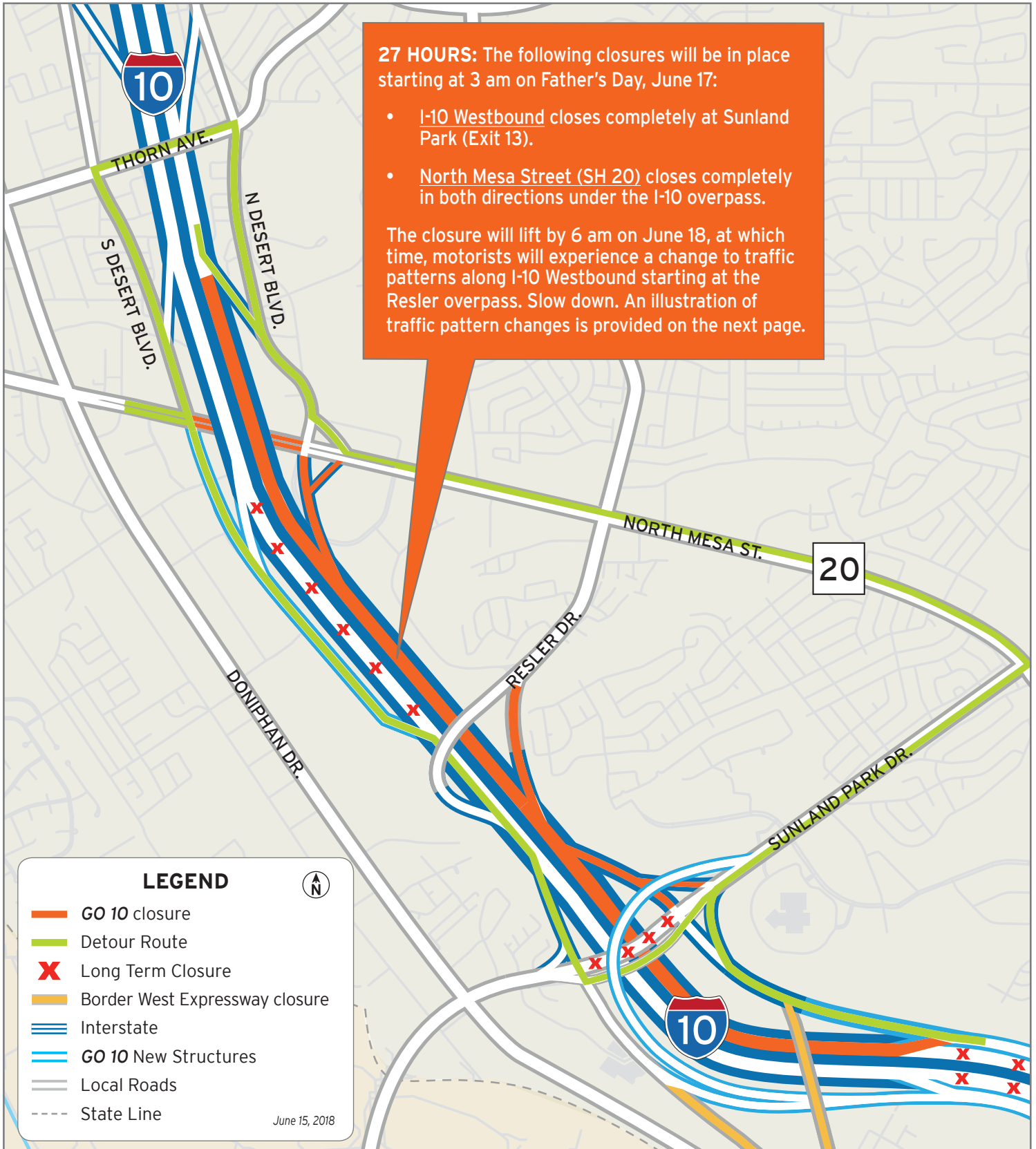


27-HOUR CLOSURE OF I-10 WESTBOUND

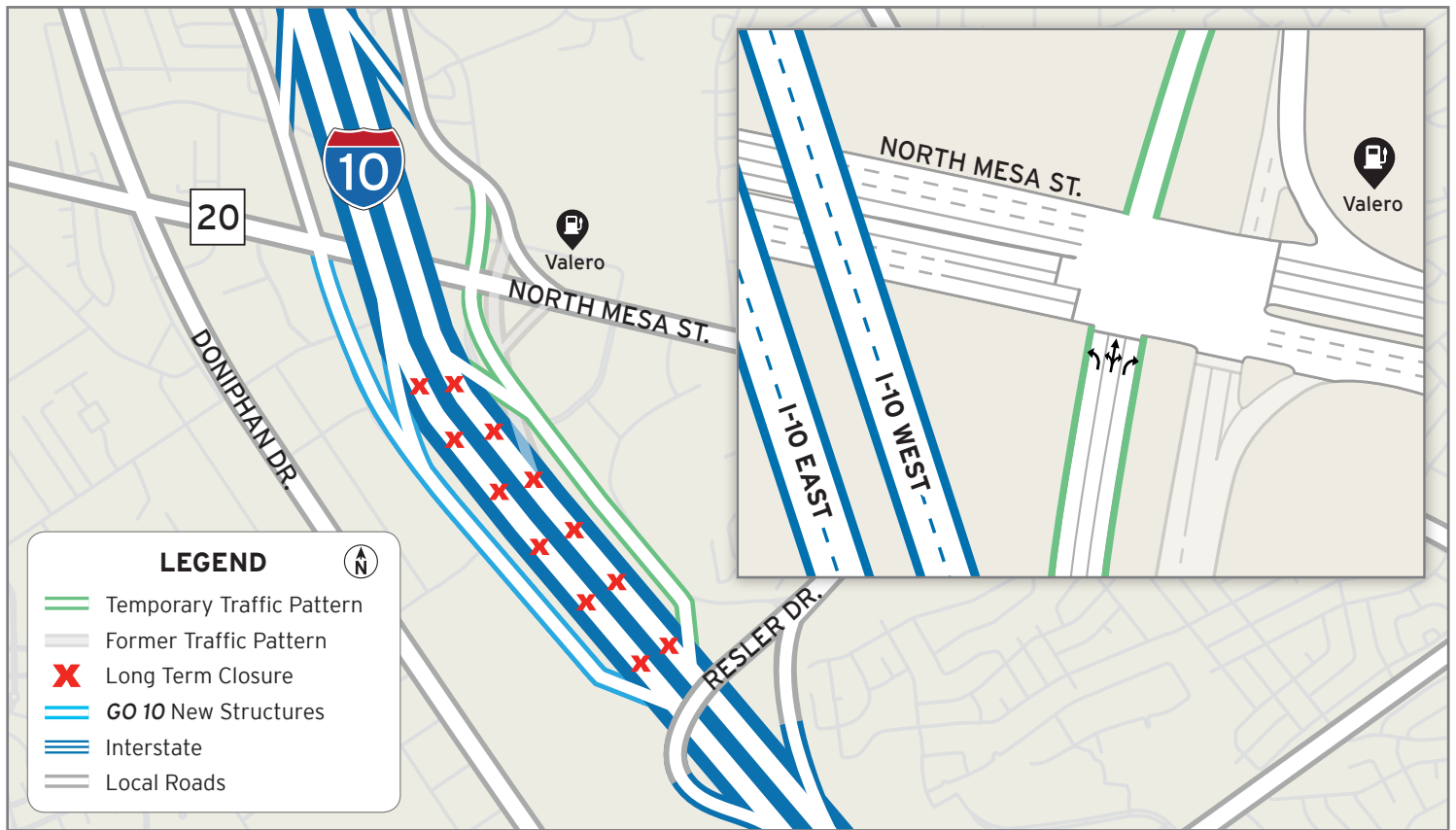
27 HOURS: The following closures will be in place starting at 3 am on Father's Day, June 17:

- I-10 Westbound closes completely at Sunland Park (Exit 13).
- North Mesa Street (SH 20) closes completely in both directions under the I-10 overpass.

The closure will lift by 6 am on June 18, at which time, motorists will experience a change to traffic patterns along I-10 Westbound starting at the Resler overpass. Slow down. An illustration of traffic pattern changes is provided on the next page.



TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGE



This illustration shows the changes that will be in place starting at 6 am on Monday, June 18.

- Motorists on I-10 Westbound near Resler Drive will be transitioned off the main lanes of I-10 and onto the new westbound collector-distributor (CD) lanes. This detour onto the CD lanes is similar to the detour now in place on I-10 Eastbound.
- Motorists exiting I-10 Westbound at North Mesa (Exit 11) will notice the signalized intersection at North Mesa Street (SH 20) will be shifted to the left. The lanes on the exit ramp will be reconfigured. Motorists will still have a left-turn only and a right-turn only lane at the signalized intersection, as illustrated.

These changes will allow crews to re-build a small section of I-10 Westbound and begin pavement replacement on North Mesa Street (SH 20).

GO 10 will upgrade all the pavement along North Mesa Street (SH 20) between Osborne Drive and Remcon Circle. Pavement replacement will take several months to complete. The goal is to be finished before December 2018.
