### Completion Milestones:

1. The North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 West is now open.
2. The turnaround lanes at I-10 and North Mesa are now opened.

**Up next, the turnaround lanes at I-10 and Sunland Park to open in weeks.**

#### I-10 East

##### Daytime

Saturday, April 13  
4 a.m. to 2 p.m.

- I-10 Eastbound will be reduced to one lane between the North Mesa overpass and the Resler flyover ramp. Crews will be installing an overhead sign structure. [No Map]

#### I-10 East

##### Overnight

Week 1: Sunday, April 14 and Monday, April 15  
Week 2: Sunday, April 21 through Tuesday, April 23  
9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 Eastbound will close completely between the Sunland Park exit ramp (Exit 13) and the Sunland Park entrance ramp. Detour: Motorists on I-10 Eastbound will exit at Sunland Park (Exit 13) and immediately re-enter I-10 East at the next ramp.
- Sunland Park Drive at the I-10 overpass will have one lane closed in each direction. Crews will continue to install a pedestrian fence along the turnaround lanes at the Sunland Park overpass. [Map 1]

- Sunland Park Drive at the I-10 overpass will have one lane closed in each direction. Crews will continue to install a pedestrian fence along the turnaround lanes at the Sunland Park overpass. [Map 2]

Exit and entrance ramps may close up to one hour prior to the start time of an I-10 closure.
