Massive closure of I-10 in both directions this Sunday, June 16.

I-10 Both Directions

27 Hours

Sunday, June 16

3 a.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

Goal: Complete roadway work by June 30.

- I-10 East will close completely between North Mesa Street (SH 20) and Sunland Park Drive. Detour: Motorists traveling on I-10 East will exit at North Mesa (exit 11), then follow North Mesa Street (SH 20) to Executive Center Blvd. Motorist may re-enter I-10 East using the Executive Center entrance ramp.
- I-10 West will close completely between Executive Center Blvd and Redd Road. Detour: Motorists traveling on I-10 West will exit at Executive Center (exit 16), follow Executive Center Blvd to North Mesa Street (SH 20), then follow the detour signs along North Mesa Street (SH 20). Motorists may re-enter I-10 West using the Redd Road entrance ramp.
- The westbound and eastbound CD lanes will close at the Sunland Park exit ramps.
- The Resler flyover entrance ramp to I-10 East will close.
- All Sunland Park entrance ramps to I-10 West and to I-10 East will close.
- Paisano Drive (US 85) – in front of the auto dealerships – will close at Sunland Park Drive.
- Crockett Street access to Paisano Drive (US 85) will close.
- Both westbound US 85 overpasses, which lead to the Sunland Park area, will close at McNutt Road.
- The eastbound-to-westbound turnaround bridge at the Sunland Park Drive overpass will close.
- The Schuster/UTEP entrance ramp to I-10 West will close.
- The North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 East will close.

Crews will be re-striping the main lanes of I-10, removing temporary barrier, and constructing permanent barrier among other activities. [Map 1]

I-10 East at Sunland

Nightly

Monday, June 17 and Tuesday, June 18

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each following morning

- I-10 East will close completely at the Sunland Park exit ramp. Detour: Motorists will exit at Sunland Park (exit 13) and follow the CD lanes to re-enter I-10 East.

I-10 West at Sunland & eastbound CDs at Sunland

Nightly

Wednesday, June 19 and Thursday, June 20

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each following morning

- I-10 West will close completely between the Sunland Park exit ramp and the Sunland Park entrance ramp. Detour: Motorists will exit at Sunland Park (exit 13) and follow the CD lanes to re-enter I-10 West at the next ramp.
- The eastbound CD lanes will close at the Sunland Park exit ramp. Detour: Motorists traveling on the eastbound CD lanes will exit at Sunland Park, then follow Sunland Park Drive to North Mesa Street (SH 20), then follow North Mesa Street (SH 20) to Executive Center Boulevard. Motorists may re-enter I-10 East using the Executive Center Boulevard entrance ramp.
- The Resler flyover entrance ramp to I-10 East will close.
- Paisano Drive (US 85) – in front of the auto dealerships – will close at Sunland Park Drive.
- The Sunland Park flyover entrance ramp to I-10 East will close.
- Crockett Street access to Paisano Drive (US 85) will close.
- The westbound to eastbound turnaround bridge at Sunland will close.

Crews will be constructing permanent concrete barrier and striping I-10 West. [Map 3]

North Mesa

Nightly

Tuesday, June 18 and Wednesday, June 19

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- North Mesa Street (SH 20) – in the westbound direction – will close completely between Remcon Circle and South Desert Boulevard.
- North Mesa Street (SH 20) – in the eastbound direction – will close completely between Osborne Drive and North Desert Boulevard.
- Restriction: Eastbound and westbound motorists who exit at North Mesa (exit 11) will be forced to turn right onto North Mesa Street (SH 20).

- Sunland Park Drive – traveling in the direction toward Doniphan Drive – will have a right lane closed the mall traffic signal lights and Machuca Road.
- The dedicated right turn lane from Sunland Park Drive to enter I-10 West will close. [No Map]

Sunland

Daytime

Thursday, June 20 and Friday, June 21

9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day

- Sunland Park Drive – traveling in the direction toward the mountain – will have a right lane closed between Machuca Road and the mall traffic signal lights.
- The dedicated right turn lane from Sunland Park Drive to Paisano Drive (US 85) will close. [No Map]

I-10 West at Sunland

27 Hours

Sunday, June 23

3 a.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- I-10 West will close completely between Sunland Park (exit 13) and North Mesa. Detour: Motorists on I-10 West will exit at Sunland Park (exit 13), then follow the CD lanes westbound. Motorists may re-enter I-10 West using the Redd Road entrance ramp.
- The North Mesa entrance to I-10 West will close.
- The Sunland Park entrance ramp to I-10 West will close.

Crews will be removing barrier, striping pavement, installing guardrail, and other punch list items. [Map 5]
