The work is dependent on weather temperatures.
Crews will try again this Sunday, Nov 18 during a 27-hour closure.**

- The exit ramps and entrance ramps at the I-10/Sunland Park interchange will close.
- Sunland Park Drive will close in both directions between Machuca Road and the mall signalized intersection.
- Paisano Drive (US 85) westbound will close at McNutt Road (NM 273). Detour: Motorists on westbound Paisano Drive (US 85) will exit at McNutt Road (NM 273).
- The Racetrack Drive entrance ramp to westbound Paisano Drive (US 85) will close.

WEATHER NOTE: If weather prevents this work activity, then the closure will be re-scheduled for the nights of Nov. 19 and Nov 20.

LANE PATTERN CHANGE: The goal is to open the Sunland Park Drive middle overpass to one lane of traffic.

- The North Mesa exit ramp (Exit 11) from I-10 Westbound will close.
- The right lane on North Mesa Street (SH 20) – in the direction traveling toward Remcon Circle – will close between South Desert Blvd and Remcon Circle.
- South Desert Boulevard will be reduced to one lane at the signalized intersection.

Crews will be conducting pavement work. [Map 2]

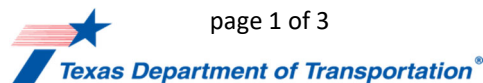

- The Racetrack Drive entrance ramp to westbound Paisano Drive (US 85) will close.
- The Sunland Park flyover entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.

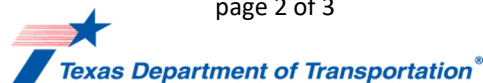

- Paisano Drive (US 85) westbound will close at McNutt Road (NM 273). Detour: Motorists on westbound Paisano Drive (US 85) will exit at McNutt Road (NM 273).
- The Racetrack Drive entrance ramp to westbound Paisano Drive (US 85) will close.

North Mesa

27 HOURS

Sunday, December 2 at 3 a.m. to Monday, December 3 at 6 a.m.

- North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close in both directions between Remcon Circle and Osborne Drive.
- All North Mesa entrance ramps and exit ramps (Exit 11) at I-10 will close. Detour: Motorists should use alternate ramps.
- McClintock Drive access to South Desert Boulevard will close.
- South Desert Boulevard will close between McClintock Drive and North Mesa Street (SH 20).

LANE PATTERN CHANGE: Crews will be changing traffic lane patterns on North Mesa Street (SH 20). The change will affect traffic traveling eastbound on North Mesa from Osborne toward Remcon.

All closures are subject to change or cancellation.

All closure times are approximate.

Exit and entrance ramps may close up to one hour prior to the start time of an I-10 closure.

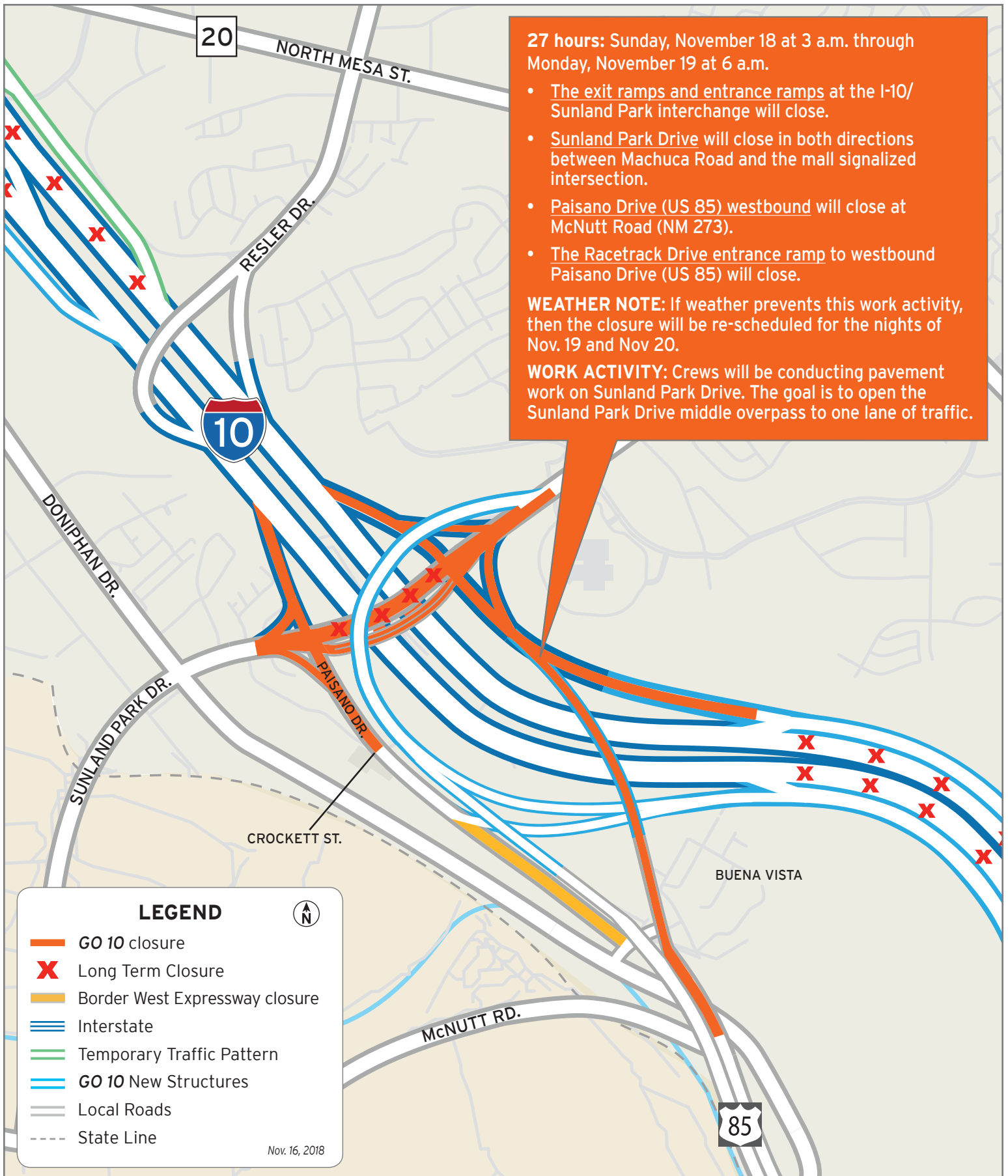



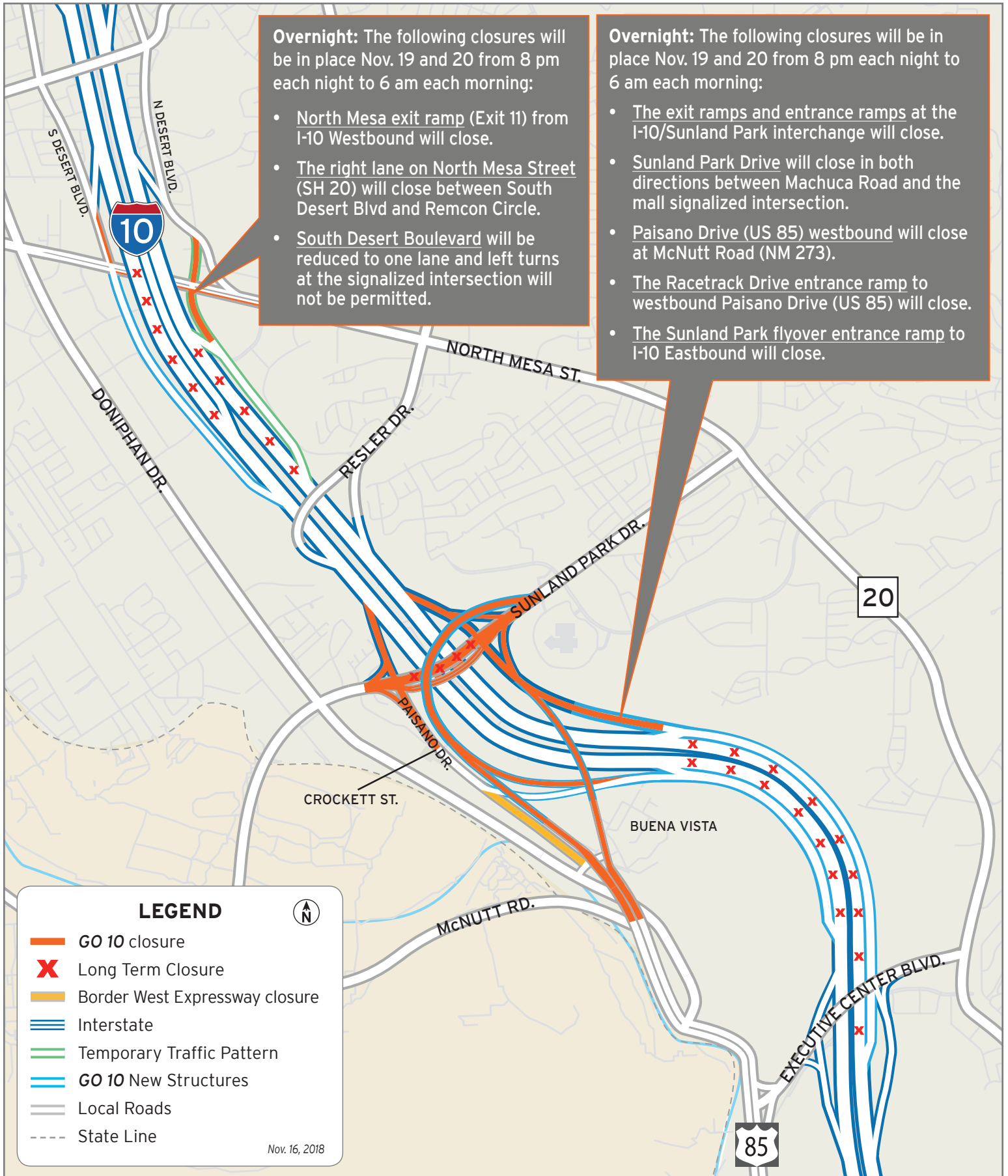
