**Much of the work this week is focused on opening the eastbound and westbound CD lanes.
CD lanes could be open by mid-May.**

I-10 East at Sunland

One Night

Monday, April 22

9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

- The main lanes of I-10 eastbound will close completely between the Sunland Park exit ramp and the Sunland Park entrance ramp. Detour: Motorists on I-10 eastbound will exit at Sunland Park (Exit 13) and immediately re-enter I-10 East at the next ramp.
- Sunland Park Drive at the I-10 overpass will have one lane closed in each direction.

Crews will continue to install a pedestrian fence along the Sunland Park overpass. [Map 1]

Sunland Park

One Day

Tuesday, April 23

9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

- The Sunland Park flyover entrance ramp to I-10 East and to US 85 East will close.

Crews will be installing a permanent barrier rail in the area. [No Map]

I-10 East at Mesa

One Night

Tuesday, April 23

9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

- I-10 eastbound will be reduced to one lane for approximately 2,000 feet starting prior to reaching the North Mesa exit ramp (Exit 11). The North Mesa eastbound exit will remain open.

Crews will be installing permanent signage in the shoulder of I-10 East. [No Map]

Resler and Sunland ramps

Two Nights

Tuesday, April 23 and Wednesday, April 24

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- The Resler entrance ramp to the eastbound CD lanes will close.
- The eastbound Sunland Park exit ramp from I-10 will close. Motorists on I-10 East who wish to access Sunland Park Drive should use the North Mesa exit ramp (Exit 11).
- Sunland Park Drive at the I-10 overpass will have one lane closed in each direction.

Crews will be re-striping the eastbound CD lanes, installing permanent signage, and installing a pedestrian fence along the Sunland Park overpass. [Map 2]

North Mesa exit

Four Days

Tuesday, April 23 through Friday, April 26

9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day

- The westbound North Mesa exit ramp (Exit 11) from I-10 will be reduced by one lane. The dedicated right turn lane will remain open.

Crews will be conducting slope work near the exit ramp. [No Map]

I-10 West at Sunland

One Night

Thursday, April 25

9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

- I-10 westbound will close completely between the Sunland Park exit ramp (Exit 13) and the Sunland Park entrance ramp. Detour: Motorists on I-10 Westbound will exit at Sunland Park (Exit 13) and immediately re-enter I-10 West at the next ramp.
- Sunland Park Drive at the I-10 overpass will have one lane closed in each direction.

Crews will continue to install a pedestrian fence along the Sunland Park overpass. [Map 3]

Sunland and Resler ramps

Four Nights

Sunday, April 28 through Wednesday, May 1

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- The Sunland Park entrance ramp to I-10 West will close. Motorists should use an alternate entrance ramp to I-10 West.
- The westbound CD lanes will close completely starting at Sunland Park Drive.
- The westbound Resler exit ramp will close. Motorists should use an alternate exit ramp.

Crews will be re-striping pavement on the westbound CD lanes and constructing barrier alongside the Sunland Park westbound entrance ramp. [Map 4]

All closures are subject to change or cancellation.

All closure times are approximate.

Exit and entrance ramps may close up to one hour prior to the start time of an I-10 closure.
