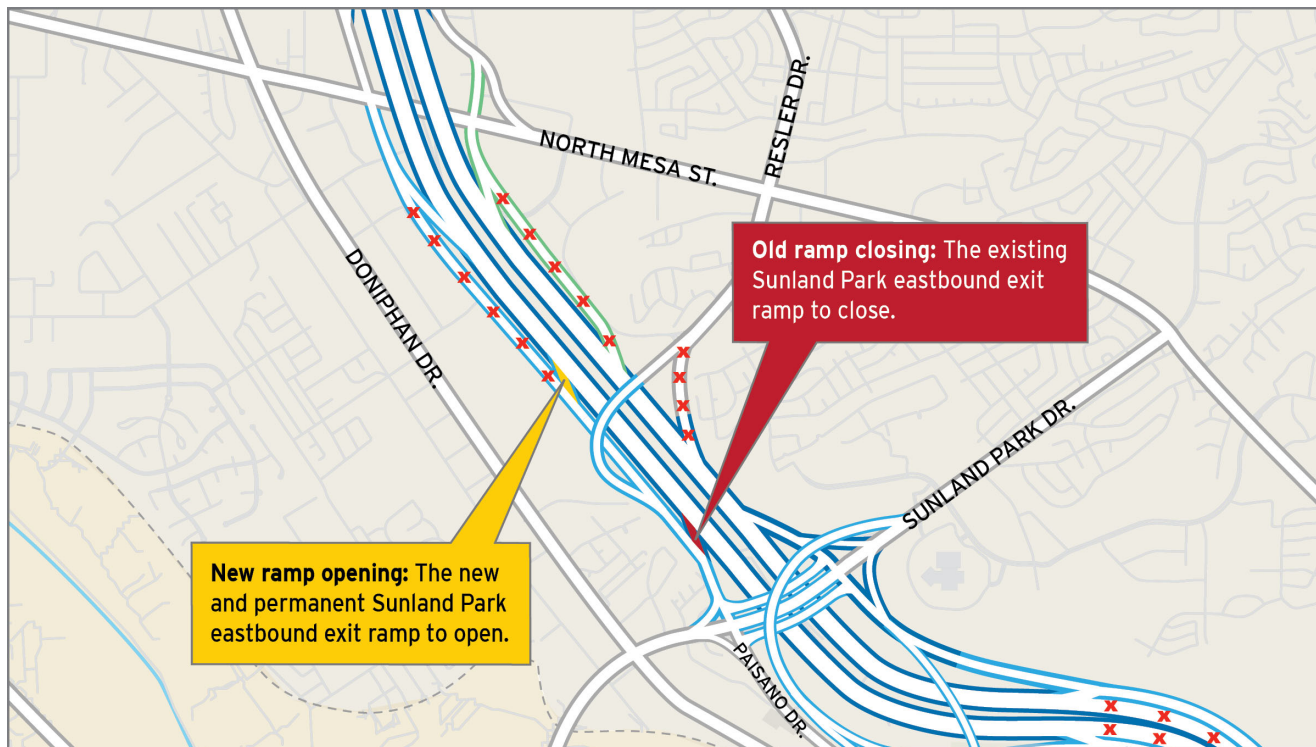
### **Resler exit ramp is now closed.**

As previously announced, the Resler westbound exit ramp (Exit 12) is now closed and will stay closed for approximately the next three months. The ramp closure is necessary while crews finish building the westbound collector-distributor (CD) lanes through the area.

### **Milestone: The permanent Sunland Park eastbound exit ramp to open**

During the week of Feb. 10, crews are aiming to close the existing Sunland Park eastbound exit ramp (Exit 13) and open the new Sunland Park eastbound exit ramp (Exit 13).

Motorists should pay attention to overhead exit signs when the change happens because the new and permanent Sunland Park exit ramp (Exit 13) will be in a different spot. The exit ramp will be accessible from I-10 Eastbound prior to reaching Resler, as illustrated.

### Scheduled closures and outcomes for the week:

#### Sunland Park

##### Daytime

Monday, February 4 through Friday, February 8

9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day

- Sunland Park Drive in the northbound direction will be reduced to one lane between Constitution Drive and the I-10 overpass.
- The Sunland Park Drive dedicated right-turn lane onto Paisano Drive may close.

Crews are raising power poles and installing boxes for permanent power. [No Map]

#### I-10 at North Mesa

##### Overnight

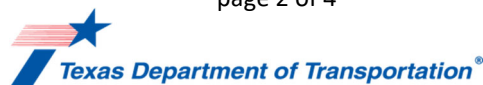
Sunday, February 3 and Monday, February 4

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 Eastbound will close completely between the Redd Road exit (Exit 9) and the Sunland Park overpass.
- The Redd Road entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.
- The Resler flyover entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.
- The North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.
- The North Mesa exit ramp (Exit 11) from I-10 Westbound will close.
- South Desert Boulevard will close between Thorn Avenue and North Mesa Street.

Detour: Motorists on I-10 Eastbound will exit at Redd Road (Exit 9), follow Redd Road to Doniphan Drive, then follow Doniphan Drive to Sunland Park Drive. Motorists may re-enter I-10 Eastbound using the Sunland Park entrance ramp. [Map 1]

#### I-10 in both directions

##### Overnight

Tuesday, February 5 through Thursday, February 7

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 Westbound will close completely between the Sunland Park exit ramp (Exit 13) and North Mesa (SH 20).
- I-10 Eastbound will close completely between the Redd Road exit (Exit 9) and the Sunland Park overpass.
- The Redd Road entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.
- The Resler flyover entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.
- The North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.
- The North Mesa exit ramp (Exit 11) from I-10 Westbound will close.
- South Desert Boulevard will close between Thorn Avenue and North Mesa Street.
- The Sunland Park entrance ramp to I-10 Westbound will close.

Detour: Motorists on I-10 Eastbound will be detoured along Doniphan Drive to re-enter I-10 Eastbound from Sunland Park Drive. Motorists on I-10 Westbound will be detoured along North Mesa Street (SH 20) to re-enter I-10 Westbound at the North Mesa entrance ramp. Follow the detour signs.


Crews will be working on the pavement of the I-10 Westbound overpass at North Mesa Street (SH 20), and they will be preparing for major changes to the eastbound Sunland Park exit ramp. [No Map]

#### North Mesa

##### 27 HOURS

Sunday, February 17 at 3 a.m. to Monday, February 18 at 6 a.m.

- Both North Mesa exit ramps (Exit 11) from I-10 Eastbound and Westbound will close.
- South Desert Boulevard will close at McClintock Street.
- North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close in both directions between Osborne Drive and Remcon Circle.

 **MILESTONE – Mesa pavement work to be completed:** Crews are targeting Feb. 17 to finish pavement work on North Mesa Street (SH 20) between Osborne Drive and Remcon Circle. Lanes will be in their final configuration and driveways to businesses will be restored. [Map 2]

Note: If this work activity is canceled, then it will be re-scheduled for Feb. 24.
