**Two more Sunday's of 27-hour closures to go, including this Sunday, June 23.
Crews are on target to finish roadwork June 30. After June 30, crews will continue to
work off the road for a couple of months to finish punch list items.**

I-10 West at Sunland

27 Hours

Sunday, June 23

3 a.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- The main lanes of I-10 West will close completely between Sunland Park (exit 13) and Redd Road. Detour: Motorists on I-10 West will exit at Sunland Park (exit 13), then follow the CD lanes westbound. Motorists may re-enter I-10 West using the Redd Road entrance ramp.
- The North Mesa entrance to the main lanes of I-10 West will close.
- The Sunland Park entrance ramp to the main lanes of I-10 West will close.

Crews will be removing barrier, striping pavement, installing guardrail, and other punch list items. [Map 1]

I-10 East at Mesa

Overnight

Monday, June 24

9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- The main lanes of I-10 East will close between the North Mesa exit ramp (exit 11) and the North Mesa entrance ramp. Detour: Motorists on I-10 East will exit at North Mesa (exit 11) and may re-enter I-10 East at the next entrance ramp.

Crews will be constructing permanent barrier wall in the area. [No Map]

I-10 West at Mesa

Overnight

Tuesday, June 25

9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- The main lanes of I-10 West will close between the North Mesa exit ramp (exit 11) and the North Mesa entrance ramp. Detour: Motorists on I-10 West will exit at North Mesa (exit 11) and may re-enter I-10 West at the next entrance ramp.

I-10 West at Sunland

Overnight

Wednesday, June 26

9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- The main lanes of I-10 West will close completely between the Sunland Park exit ramp (exit 13) and the North Mesa entrance ramp. Detour: Motorists on I-10 West will exit at Sunland Park (exit 13), follow the westbound CD lanes through the North Mesa Street (SH 20) signalized intersection, and re-enter the main lanes of I-10 West at the North Mesa westbound entrance ramp.
- The Sunland Park westbound entrance ramp to the main lanes of I-10 West will close.

Crews will be working on a punch list of various work activities. [Map 2]

I-10 East at Mesa and

I-10 West at Sunland

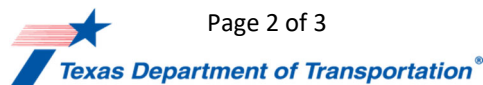
Overnight

Thursday, June 27

9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- The main lanes of I-10 East will close completely between the North Mesa exit ramp (exit 11) and the Sunland Park Drive overpass. Detour: Motorists on I-10 East will exit at North Mesa (exit 11), pass through the North Mesa Street (SH 20) signalized intersection to access the eastbound CD lanes, then follow the CD lanes to re-enter the main lanes of I-10 East.
- The westbound CD lanes will close completely between the Sunland Park exit ramp (exit 13) and the Sunland Park entrance ramp. Detour: Motorists who intend to travel on the westbound CD lanes will be detoured through the signalize intersection of Sunland Park Drive before being able to continue on the westbound CD lanes. The Resler exit ramp will be open.
- The US 85 westbound overpasses, which lead to the Sunland Park area, will close at McNutt Road and at Racetrack Drive.

Miscellaneous punch list work is required in the area, including repairs to a cracked retaining wall under the Sunland Park Drive overpass. [Map 3]

27 Hours

Sunday, June 30

3 a.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- The main lanes of I-10 West will close completely between Executive Center Blvd (exit 16) and North Mesa. Detour: Motorists on I-10 West will exit at Executive Center Blvd, follow Executive Center Blvd to North Mesa Street (SH 20), then follow North Mesa Street (SH 20) to the North Mesa entrance ramp to re-enter I-10 West.
- The Sunland Park entrance ramp to the main lanes of I-10 West will close.
- The Schuster/UTEP entrance ramp to I-10 West will close.

Exit and entrance ramps may close up to one hour prior to the start time of an I-10 closure.
