After Thanksgiving, changes to traffic lane patterns may be coming to the exit ramps at North Mesa.

Be Careful: The leading causes of fatal work zone crashes statewide are speeding and failure to stay in a single lane.

North Mesa

Overnight

Monday, November 26 and Tuesday, November 27

8 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close in both directions between Remcon Circle and Osborne Drive.
- All North Mesa entrance ramps and exit ramps (Exit 11) at I-10 will close.
- South Desert Boulevard will close between McClintock Drive and North Mesa Street (SH 20).
- McClintock Drive access to South Desert Boulevard will close.

LANE PATTERN CHANGE: Crews will be re-configuring traffic lanes on the eastbound and westbound North Mesa exit ramps.

Overnight

Tuesday, November 27 through Thursday, November 29

8 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- One lane in each direction on North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close between Remcon Circle and Osborne Drive.
- North Mesa exit ramp (Exit 11) from I-10 Eastbound will close.
- South Desert Boulevard will close between McClintock Drive and North Mesa Street (SH 20).
- McClintock Drive access to South Desert Boulevard will close.

Crews will be conducting pavement work.

Sunland Park

Overnight

Tuesday, November 27 through Thursday, November 29

8 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- Sunland Park Drive will close in both directions between Machuca Road and the mall signalized intersection.
- The Sunland Park exit ramp (Exit 13) from I-10 Westbound will close.

- The Sunland Park exit ramp (Exit 13) from I-10 Eastbound will be open; however, motorists will not be able to turn left onto Sunland Park Drive.
- Paisano Drive (US 85) westbound will close at McNutt Road (NM 273). Detour: Motorists on westbound Paisano Drive (US 85) will exit at McNutt Road (NM 273).
- The Racetrack Drive entrance ramp to westbound Paisano Drive (US 85) will close. Crews will be constructing the median and a sidewalk.

Developing

The following closures are still developing, meaning, details may change.

Sunland Park

27 HOURS

Sunday, December 2 at 3 a.m. to Monday, December 3 at 6 a.m.

- The exit ramps and entrance ramps at the I-10/Sunland Park interchange will close.
- Sunland Park Drive will close in both directions between Machuca Road and the mall signalized intersection.
- Paisano Drive (US 85) westbound will close at McNutt Road (NM 273). Detour: Motorists on westbound Paisano Drive (US 85) will exit at McNutt Road (NM 273).
- The Racetrack Drive entrance ramp to westbound Paisano Drive (US 85) will close.

LANE PATTERN CHANGE: The goal is to open more traffic lanes on the Sunland Park Drive middle overpass.

WEATHER NOTE: This work activity is dependent on weather temperatures and may be re-scheduled.

North Mesa

Overnight

Monday, December 3 through Wednesday, December 5

8 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 Eastbound will close at the North Mesa exit ramp (Exit 11). NOTE: Exiting vehicles will not be allowed to continue straight at the signalized intersection.
- The North Mesa Street (SH 20) entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.

MILESTONE: Crews will be re-configuring traffic lane patterns, placing vehicles on the permanent eastbound North Mesa entrance ramp.

Sunday, December 9 at 3 a.m. to Monday, December 10 at 6 a.m.

- North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close in both directions between Remcon Circle and Osborne Drive.
- All North Mesa entrance ramps and exit ramps (Exit 11) at I-10 will close.
- South Desert Boulevard will close between McClintock Drive and North Mesa Street (SH 20).
- McClintock Drive access to South Desert Boulevard will close.

LANE PATTERN CHANGE: Crews will be changing traffic lane patterns on North Mesa Street (SH 20). The change will affect traffic traveling eastbound on North Mesa from Osborne toward Remcon.
