27-hour closure of I-10 West set for Sunday, July 1

Resler Update: The plan is to keep the Resler Drive exit open through the summer, but, in the fall, the Resler Drive exit will close for approximately two months.

I-10 West at Resler

Overnight

Monday, June 25 and Tuesday, June 26

8 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. the next morning

- I-10 Westbound will reduce to one lane between Resler Drive and Thorn Avenue.

Crews will continue to pour concrete pavement onto the I-10 overpass at North Mesa Street. [No Map]

I-10 West at Mesa

Overnight

Tuesday, June 26 and Wednesday, June 27

8 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. the next morning

- The North Mesa Street exit ramp from I-10 Westbound will close.

Crews will install pipe underneath and across the ramp. [No Map]

I-10 West and North Mesa Street

DAY AND NIGHT

Sunday, July 1

27 HOURS -- 3 a.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- I-10 Westbound will close completely at North Mesa Street (Exit 11).
- Motorists on I-10 Westbound will exit at North Mesa Street (Exit 11) and follow the frontage to re-enter I-10 at the next entrance ramp.

13 HOURS – 3 a.m. to 4 p.m.

- North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close completely in both directions under the I-10 overpass.
- All entrance ramps to I-10 from North Mesa Street will be open.
- Follow the detour signs.

Crews will be placing bridge deck panels and pouring concrete onto the I-10 overpass at North Mesa Street. [Map 1]

Advance Notice

The following closures are still developing. Details, such as dates, may change.

If weather or other factors do not permit the closure of I-10 Westbound on July 1, then the following closure will be implemented:

DAY AND NIGHT

Sunday, July 8

27 HOURS -- 3 a.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- I-10 Westbound will close completely at North Mesa Street (Exit 11).
- Motorists on I-10 Westbound will exit at North Mesa Street (Exit 11) and follow the frontage to re-enter I-10 at the next entrance ramp.

13 HOURS – 3 a.m. to 4 p.m.

- North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close completely in both directions under the I-10 overpass.
- All entrance ramps to I-10 from North Mesa Street will be open.
- Follow the detour signs.

Overnight

Monday, July 9 through Thursday, July 12

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each following morning

- I-10 Eastbound will close completely at North Mesa (Exit 11). Motorists will be detoured onto Doniphan Drive and will be able to re-enter I-10 Eastbound from Sunland Park Drive.
- The North Mesa Street entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.
- I-10 Westbound will close completely at Sunland Park (Exit 13). Motorists will be detoured onto North Mesa Street (SH 20) to the North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 Westbound.
- The Sunland Park Drive overpass will close completely in both directions.

Crews will be setting bridge girders for the new Sunland Park Drive center overpass.

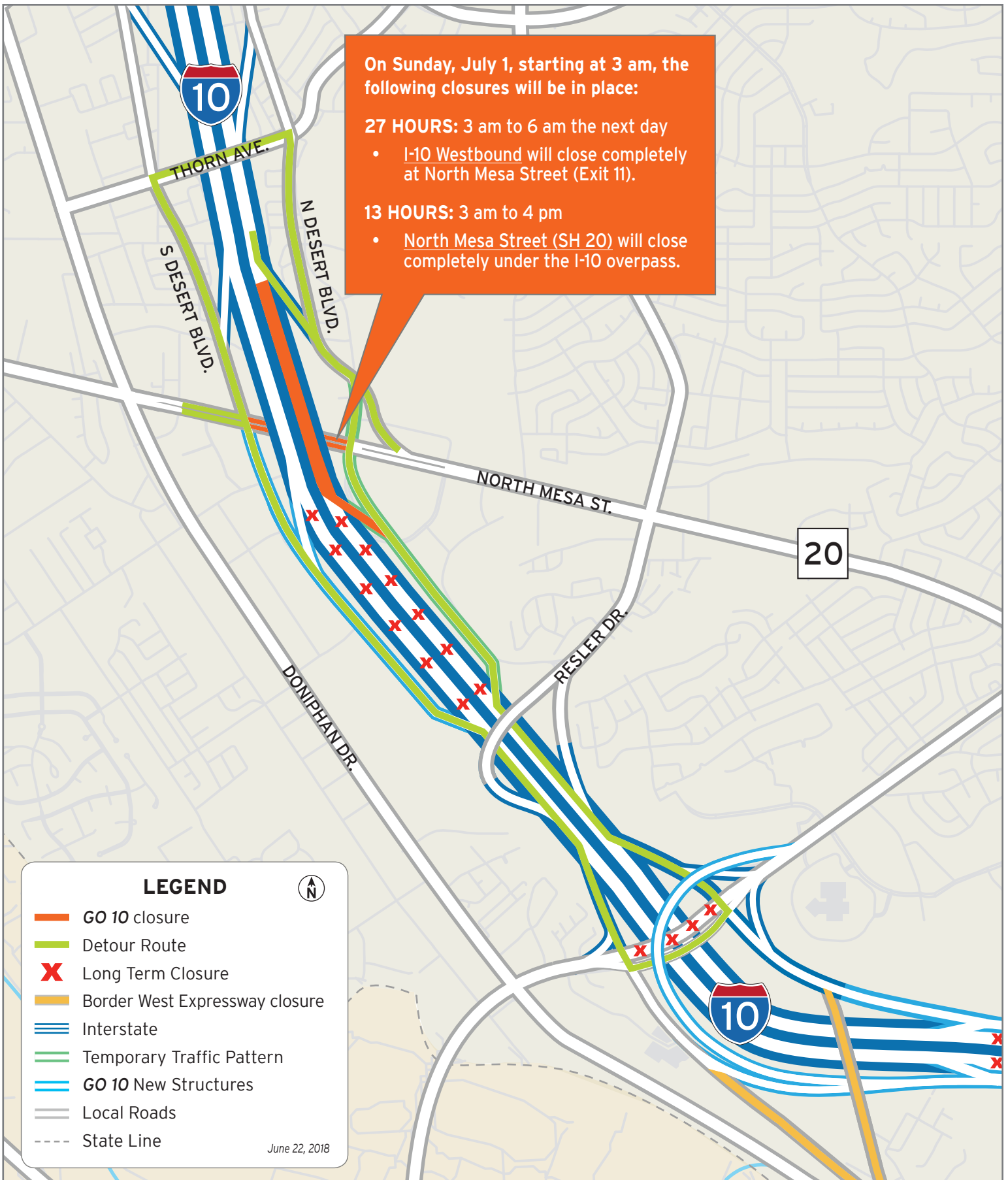
On Sunday, July 1, starting at 3 am, the following closures will be in place:
