27-hour closure of I-10 West happens this Sunday, July 1 If weather or other factors prevent this Sunday's closure from happening, then it will be re-scheduled for Sunday, July 8.

I-10 and North Mesa Street



DAY AND NIGHT

Sunday, July 1

27 HOURS -- 3 a.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- I-10 Westbound will close completely at the North Mesa Street overpass.
- Motorists on I-10 Westbound will exit at North Mesa Street (Exit 11) and follow the frontage to re-enter I-10 at the next entrance ramp.

Crews will be pouring concrete onto the I-10 overpass at North Mesa Street (SH 20).

NOTE: For several hours during the closure of I-10 Westbound, it may seem as though no work is taking place; but in fact, the freshly poured concrete will be curing (drying and hardening).

13 HOURS – 3 a.m. to 4 p.m.

- North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close completely in both directions under the I-10 overpass.
- All entrance ramps to I-10 from North Mesa Street will be open.

Crews will be pouring concrete onto the I-10 overpass at North Mesa Street.

Follow the detour signs.

9 HOURS – 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- I-10 Eastbound will close completely at the North Mesa Street overpass.
- The North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.
- Motorists on I-10 Eastbound will exit at North Mesa (Exit 11) and follow North Mesa Street to Doniphan Drive, then follow Doniphan Drive to Sunland Park Drive. Motorists may enter I-10 Eastbound using the Sunland Park entrance ramp.

Crews will be making improvements to pavement markers.

I-10 West at Sunland

Overnight

Monday, July 2

9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next morning

- I-10 Westbound will close completely at the Sunland Park overpass.
- The Sunland Park entrance ramp to I-10 Westbound will close.
- Motorists on I-10 Westbound will exit at Sunland Park (Exit 13) and follow Sunland Park Drive to North Mesa Street, then follow North Mesa Street to the entrance ramp to I-10 Westbound.

Crews will be making improvements to pavement markers. [Map 1]

Advance Notice

The following closures are still developing. Details, such as dates, may change.

If weather or other factors do not permit the closure of I-10 Westbound on July 1 (as described above), then the following closure will be implemented:

DAY AND NIGHT

Sunday, July 8

27 HOURS -- 3 a.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- I-10 Westbound will close completely at the North Mesa overpass.
- Motorists on I-10 Westbound will exit at North Mesa Street (Exit 11) and follow the frontage to re-enter I-10 at the next entrance ramp.

13 HOURS – 3 a.m. to 4 p.m.

- North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close completely in both directions under the I-10 overpass.
- All entrance ramps to I-10 from North Mesa Street will be open.
- Follow the detour signs.

Overnight

Monday, July 9 through Thursday, July 12

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each following morning

- I-10 Eastbound will close completely at the North Mesa overpass. Motorists will be detoured onto Doniphan Drive and will be able to re-enter I-10 Eastbound from Sunland Park Drive.

- I-10 Westbound will close completely at the Sunland Park overpass. Motorists will be detoured onto North Mesa Street (SH 20) to the North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 Westbound.
- The Sunland Park Drive overpass will close completely in both directions.
- The Resler Drive entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.

Crews will be setting bridge girders for the new Sunland Park Drive center overpass.

Overnight

Monday, July 16 through Thursday, July 19

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each following morning

- I-10 Eastbound will close completely at the Sunland Park overpass.

All closures are subject to change.

All closure times are approximate.

Exit and entrance ramps may close up to one hour prior to the start time of an I-10 closure.

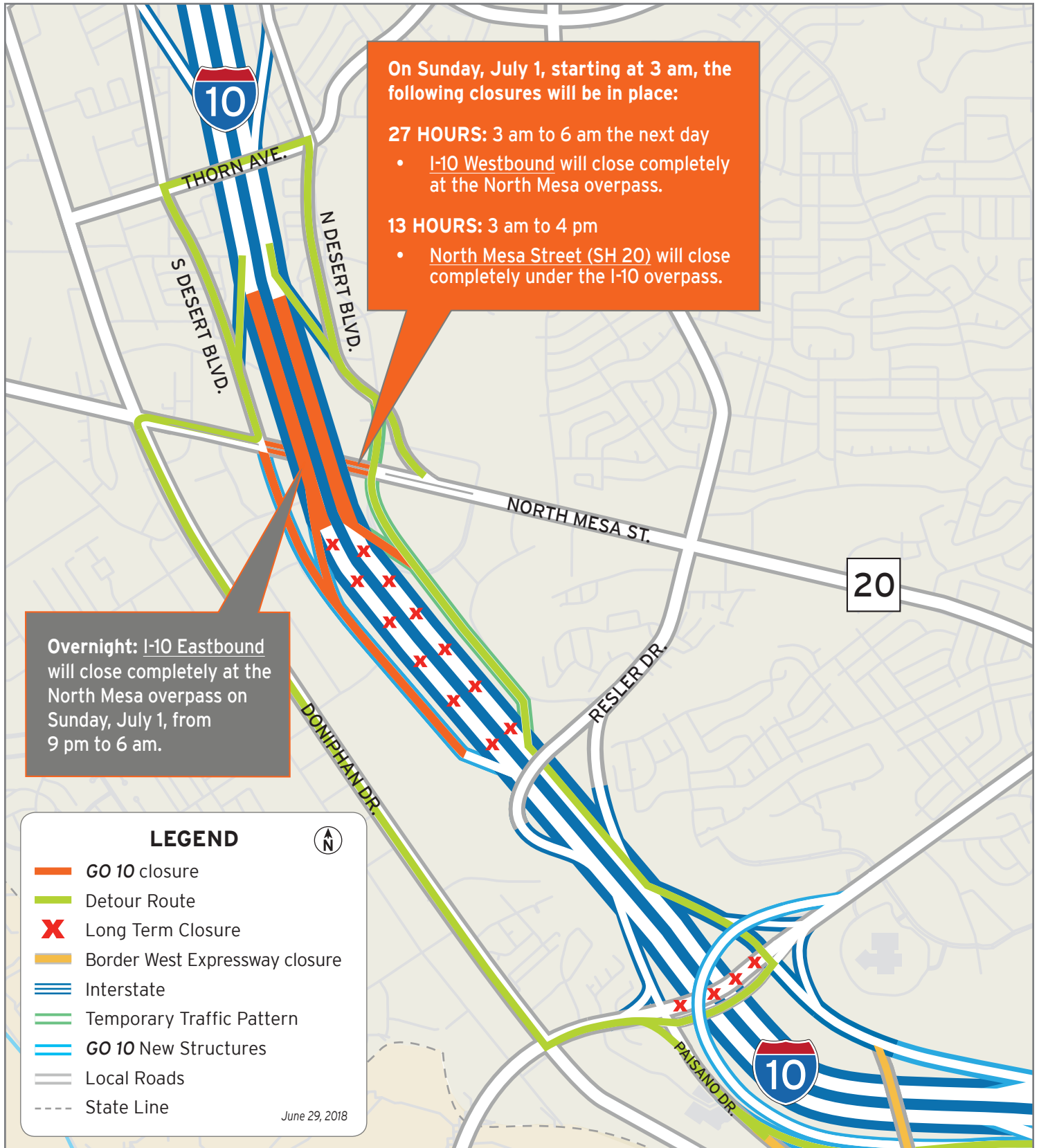

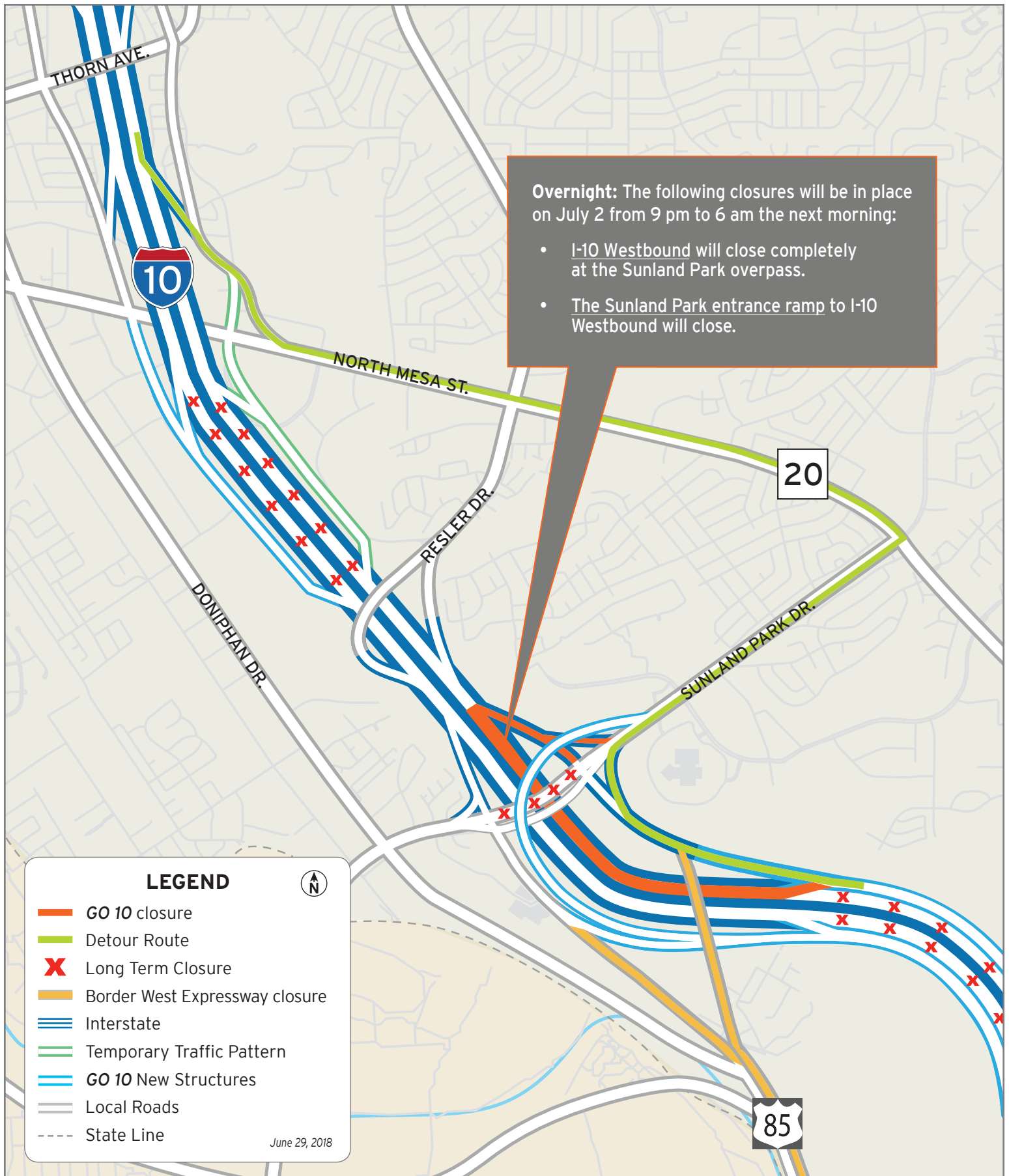
