I-10 closures will occur nightly Monday through Thursday.

Fact: The **GO 10** project is halfway through its four-year schedule. In the first two years, work occurred mostly along the outside of I-10. For the remaining two years, work will impact I-10 more directly. Drive carefully through the work zone as it continues to change from day to day.

I-10 & Mesa

Overnight

Monday, June 5

9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the following morning

- I-10 Eastbound will close **completely** at the North Mesa Exit (Exit 11).
- The Resler Flyover Ramp will close.

Detour: Traffic on I-10 East will exit at North Mesa Street (Exit 11), take North Mesa Street to Doniphan Drive, and take Doniphan Drive to Sunland Park Drive. Vehicles will be able to enter I-10 East from Sunland Park Drive. Follow the detour signs.

Crews will conduct bridge work on the Resler Flyover Ramp. [Map 1]

Overnight

Monday, June 5 through Thursday, June 8

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 in both directions will be reduced to one lane between North Mesa Street and Resler Drive.

Crews will install permanent lines for TxDOT traffic cameras [No Map]

I-10 & Resler

Overnight

Tuesday, June 6

9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the following morning

- I-10 Westbound will close **completely** at the Resler Exit (Exit 12).
- The Resler Flyover Ramp will close.

Detour: Traffic on I-10 West will exit at Resler Drive (Exit 12), take Resler Drive to North Mesa Street (SH 20), and re-enter I-10 at the North Mesa/I-10 interchange. Follow the detour signs.

Crews will conduct bridge work on the Resler Flyover Ramp. [Map 1]

Overnight

Wednesday, June 7

9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next morning

- I-10 Eastbound will close **completely** at the Sunland Park Exit (Exit 13).

Detour: Traffic on I-10 East will exit at Sunland Park (Exit 13) and will be able to re-enter I-10 East immediately at the Sunland Park Entrance Ramp.

Crews will set bridge deck panels onto the new Sunland Park Overpass turnaround lanes. [Map 2]

Overnight

Thursday, June 8

9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next morning

- I-10 Westbound will close **completely** at the Sunland Park Exit (Exit 13).

Detour: Traffic on I-10 West will exit at Sunland Park (Exit 13) and will be able to re-enter I-10 West immediately at the Sunland Park Entrance Ramp.

Crews will set bridge deck panels onto the new Sunland Park Overpass turnaround lanes. [Map 2]

9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next morning

- The I-10 Eastbound entrance ramp from the Sunland Drive/Paisano Drive intersection will close.

Crews will hang beams. An illustration map will be provided next week.

Overnight

Monday, June 12 and Tuesday, June 13

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 in both directions will close **completely** at the Sunland Park Exits (Exit 13).
- The Sunland Park Entrance Ramp to I-10 East will close.

This closure is subject to change. Finalized information, including detour route, will be provided next week.

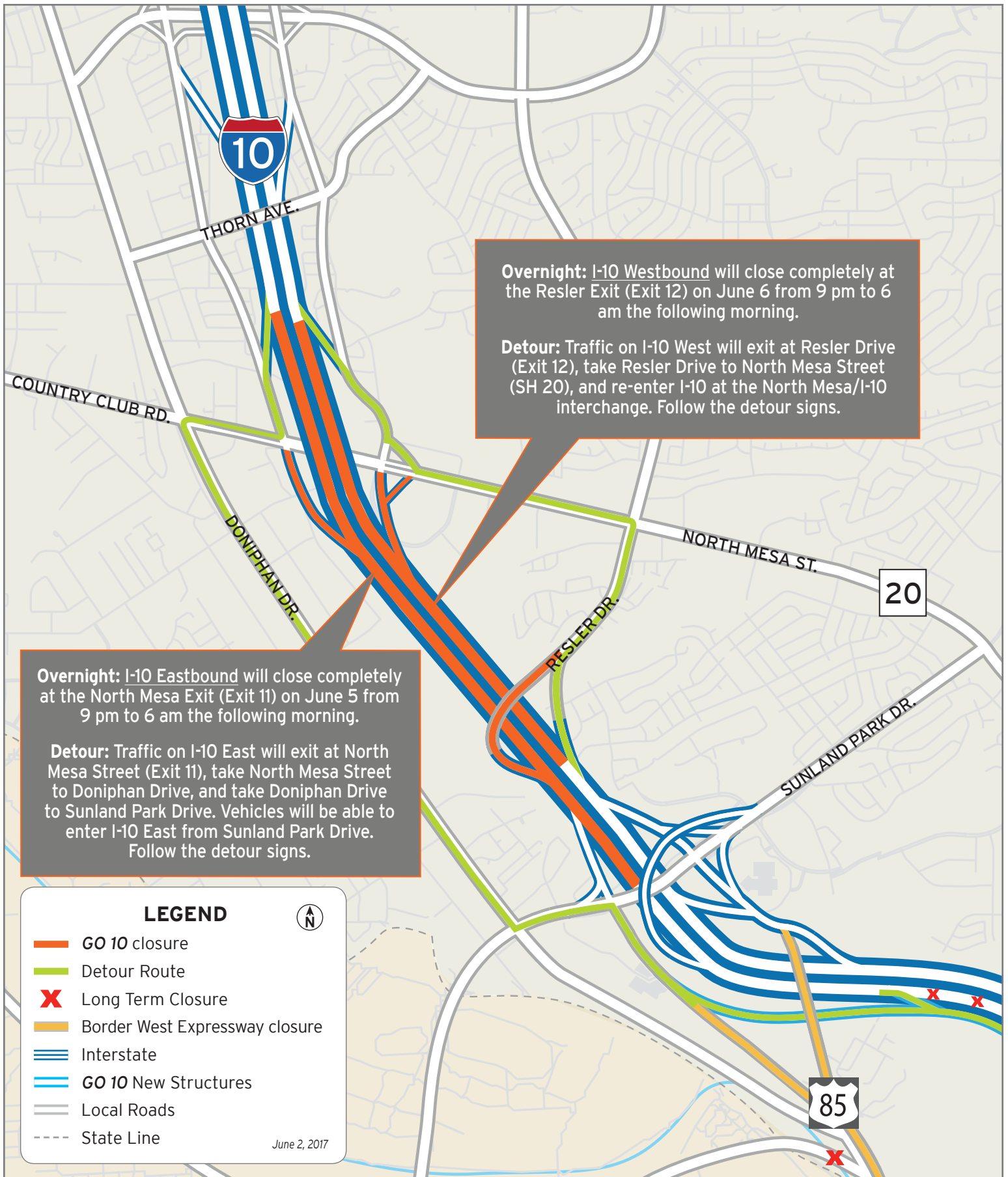

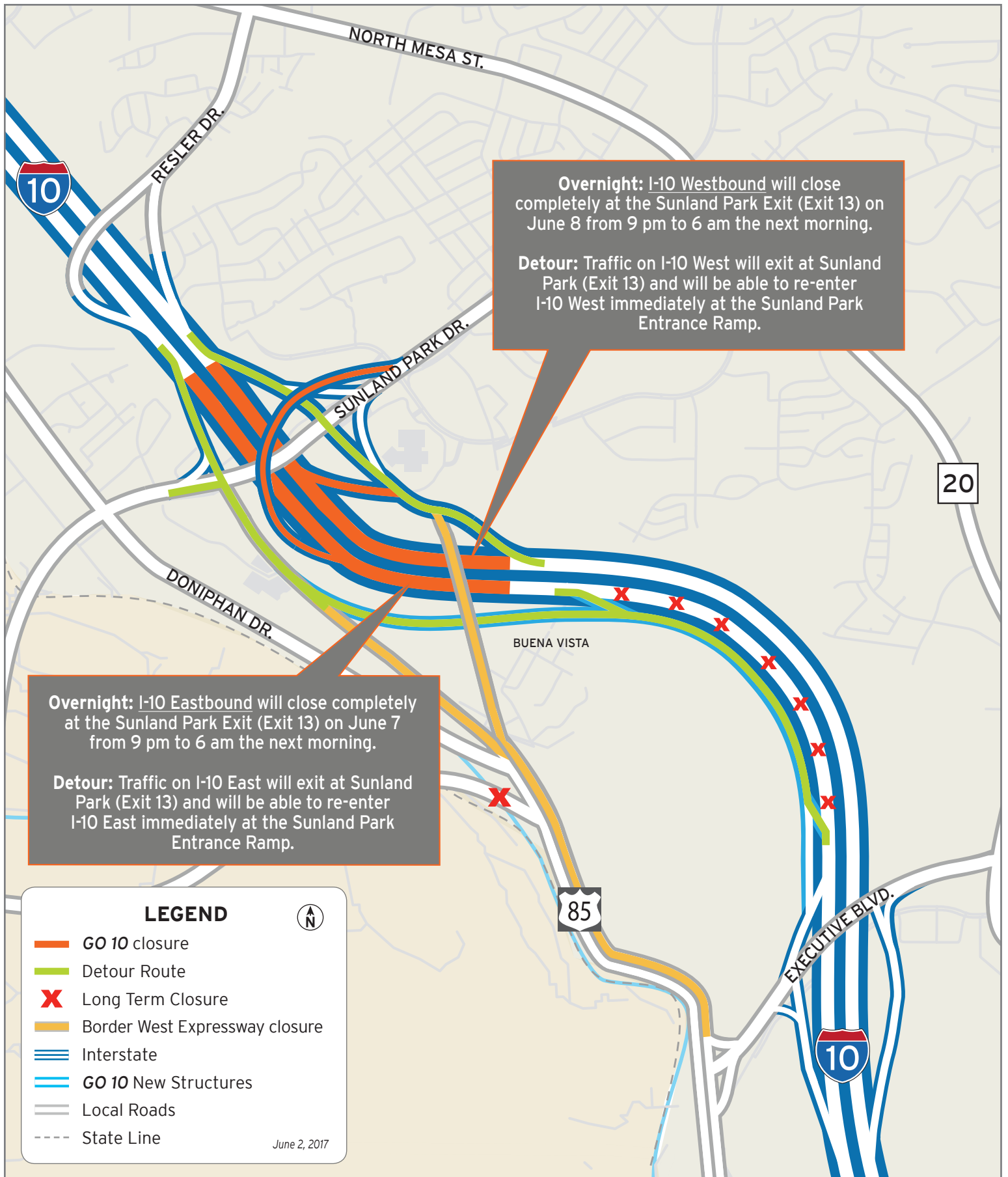
