On Nov. 11 and 18, GO 10 will open the Sunland Park main overpass in two phases. It will require two 27-hour closures of the I-10/Sunland Park interchange.

#### **I-10 Both Directions**

## **Overnight**

Sunday, November 4 through Thursday, November 8

8 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 Eastbound will close at Sunland Park (Exit 13). Detour: Motorists will exit at Sunland Park and follow Sunland Park Drive to Doniphan Drive, then follow Doniphan Drive to Executive Center Boulevard. Motorists may re-enter I-10 Eastbound at the Executive Center entrance ramp.
- I-10 Westbound will close at Executive Center (Exit 16). Detour: Motorists will exit at Executive Center, then follow the detour signs to North Mesa Street (SH 20). The North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 Westbound will be open.
- Sunland Park Drive will close in both directions at the I-10 overpass. Detour: Motorists should use an alternate route.
- Paisano Drive (US 85) westbound will close at McNutt Road (NM 273). Detour: Motorists on westbound Paisano Drive (US 85) will exit at McNutt Road (NM 273).
- Both Sunland Park entrance ramps to I-10 Eastbound will close.
- Crockett Street access to Paisano Drive (US 85) will close.
- The Resler flyover entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.
- The Sunland Park entrance ramp to I-10 Westbound will close.
- The Schuster/UTEP entrance ramp to I-10 Westbound will close.

Crews will be painting structures, hauling dirt, and preparing for an upcoming lane pattern change on Sunland Park Drive. [Map 1]

- North Mesa Street (SH 20) eastbound lanes (traveling in the direction toward Remcon) will close between Osborne Drive and Remcon Circle.
- The North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close. Detour: Motorists should use an alternate entrance ramp. Note: The Sunland Park eastbound entrance ramps will be closed during this time.
- The North Mesa exit ramp from I-10 Eastbound will be open; however, motorists will only be able to turn right onto North Mesa Street (SH 20) at the North Mesa signalized intersection.

Crews will be installing concrete pavement on North Mesa Street (SH 20). [Map 1]

### **Sunland Park**

### 27 HOURS

Sunday, November 11 at 3 a.m. through Monday, November 12 at 6 a.m.

- The exit ramps and entrance ramps at the I-10/Sunland Park interchange will close.
- Sunland Park Drive will close in both directions between Machuca Road and South Mesa Hills Drive. Detour: Motorists should use an alternate route.
- The Sunland Park flyover entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.

Detour: Follow the detour signs in place.

TRAFFIC SHIFT, Part 1 of 2: Crews will be re-configuring traffic lane patterns on Sunland Park Drive. By the morning of Nov. 12, traffic on Sunland Park Drive traveling in the direction from South Mesa Hills Drive toward Doniphan Drive will be placed on the main, center overpass of Sunland Park Drive.

#### 27 HOURS

Sunday, November 18 at 3 a.m. through Monday, November 19 at 6 a.m.

- The exit ramps and entrance ramps at the I-10/Sunland Park interchange will close.
- Sunland Park Drive will close in both directions between Machuca Road and South Mesa Hills Drive. Detour: Motorists should use an alternate route.
- The Sunland Park flyover entrance ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.

Detour: Follow the detour signs in place.

TRAFFIC SHIFT, Part 2 of 2: Crews will be re-configuring traffic lane patterns on Sunland Park Drive. By the morning of Nov. 19, traffic on Sunland Park Drive traveling in the direction from Doniphan Drive toward South Mesa Hills Drive will be placed on the main, center overpass of Sunland Park Drive.

## **North Mesa**

#### 27 HOURS

Sunday, December 2 at 3 a.m. to Monday, December 3 at 6 a.m.

- North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close in both directions between Remcon Circle and Osborne Drive.
- All North Mesa entrance ramps and exit ramps (Exit 11) at I-10 will close. Detour: Motorists should use alternate ramps.
- McClintock Drive access to South Desert Boulevard will close.
- South Desert Boulevard will close between McClintock Drive and North Mesa Street (SH 20).

Crews will be changing traffic lane patterns on North Mesa Street (SH 20) between Osborne Drive and Remcon Circle. The change will affect traffic traveling eastbound from Osborne toward Remcon.

All closures are subject to change or cancellation.

All closure times are approximate.

Exit and entrance ramps may close up to one hour prior to the start time of an I-10 closure.
