This Sunday's 27-hour closure will result in a change to lane patterns on I-10 East near Buena Vista.

I-10 East at Redd

27 Hours

Sunday, June 2

3 a.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- I-10 East will close completely between Redd Road and Executive Center Blvd. Detour: Motorists on I-10 East will exit at Redd Road (exit 9), follow South Desert Blvd to North Mesa Street (SH 20), follow North Mesa Street (SH 20) to Executive Center Blvd. Re-enter I-10 East using the Executive Center entrance ramp.
- The North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 East will close.
- The eastbound collector-distributor (CD) lanes will close completely at North Mesa Street (SH 20).
- Paisano Drive (US 85) – in front of the auto dealerships – will close completely starting at Sunland Park Drive.
- Crockett Street access to Paisano Drive (US 85) will close.
- Both turnaround bridges at Sunland Park Drive will close.
- The westbound-to-eastbound turnaround bridge at North Mesa Street will close.
- The Sunland Park flyover ramp and the Resler flyover ramp will close.

MILESTONE: When this 27-hour closure lifts, motorists on I-10 East can expect a lane pattern change near Buena Vista that will place them on the main lanes of I-10. The graphic below shows the lane pattern change. This change comes after two years of drivers being detoured onto the CD lanes. [Map 1]

US 85 Westbound

Daytime

Monday, June 3 and Tuesday, June 4

9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day

- The US 85 westbound overpass, which leads to the Sunland Park signalized intersection, will close.
- The right lane on the US 85 westbound overpass, which leads to the westbound CD lanes near Sunland Park, will close.

Crews will be painting barrier rail in the area. [Map 2]

North Mesa

Daytime

Monday, June 3 through Friday, June 7

9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day

- The right lane on eastbound North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close between Osborne Drive and South Desert Blvd.
- The right lane on South Desert Blvd will close for about 300 feet starting at North Mesa Street (SH 20).

Crews will be installing heavy concrete pipes. [No Map]

I-10 West at Executive

Overnight

Monday, June 3

9 p.m. to 6 a.m. the next morning

- I-10 West will close completely between the Executive Center exit ramp and the Sunland Park entrance ramp. Detour: Motorists will exit at Executive Center (exit 16), follow Executive Center Blvd to North Mesa (SH 20), follow North Mesa (SH 20) to Sunland Park Drive, then follow Sunland Park Drive to the entrance ramp to I-10 West.
- The Schuster/UTEP entrance ramp to I-10 West will close.

Crews will be constructing permanent concrete barrier. [Map 3]

Crews will be constructing permanent concrete barrier. [Map 5]

I-10 East at Mesa

27 Hours

Sunday, June 9

3 a.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- I-10 East will close completely between North Mesa Street (SH 20) and Sunland Park Drive. Detour: Motorists traveling on I-10 East will be detoured onto the eastbound CD lanes, bypassing all signalized intersections.
- The North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 East will close.

Crews will be removing barrier and striping I-10 pavement to final configuration. [Map 6]

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each following morning

- I-10 East will close completely at the Sunland Park exit ramp. Detour: Motorists will exit at Sunland Park (exit 13) and follow the CD lanes to re-enter I-10 East. Crews will be constructing permanent concrete barrier. [No Map]

I-10 Both Directions

27 Hours

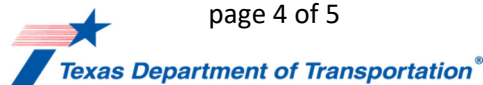
Sunday, June 16

3 a.m. to 6 a.m. the next day

- I-10 East will close completely between North Mesa Street (SH 20) and Sunland Park Drive. Detour: Motorists traveling on I-10 East will be detoured onto the eastbound CD lanes, bypassing all signalized intersections.
- I-10 West will close completely between Executive Center Blvd and Redd Road. Detour: Motorists traveling on I-10 West will exit at Executive Center (exit 16), follow Executive Center Blvd to North Mesa Street (SH 20), then follow the detour signs along North Mesa Street (SH 20). Motorists may re-enter I-10 West using the Redd Road entrance ramp.
- The westbound CD lanes will be closed starting at Sunland Park.
- All Sunland Park entrance ramps to I-10 West will be closed.
- Both westbound US 85 overpasses, which lead to the Sunland Park area, will close.
- The eastbound-to-westbound turnaround bridge at the Sunland Park Drive overpass will close.
- The Schuster/UTEP entrance ramp to I-10 West will close.
- The North Mesa entrance ramp to I-10 East will close.

Crews will be removing barrier, striping I-10 pavement to final configuration, among other activities. [No Map]
