TRAFFIC ADVISORY Resler exit ramp to open Friday.

El Paso, Texas – **GO 10** crews will open the Resler Drive westbound exit ramp by 6 a.m. on Friday, March 29. To reach the new and permanent Resler exit ramp, motorists will have to exit from I-10 prior to reaching the Sunland Park Drive overpass. Follow the exit signs.

Starting on Friday, motorists who intend to use the Resler Drive exit ramp (Exit 12) should expect to continue to navigate through the Sunland Park Drive signalized intersection on a *temporary basis* while crews complete the westbound CD lanes. Since the Resler Drive exit ramp closed on January 29, 2019, motorists have been detoured through a signalized intersection on Sunland Park Drive. In the final design, motorists will be able to travel on the CD lanes to bypass Sunland Park Drive, including the traffic signals, and reach the Resler Drive exit ramp (Exit 12).

Also on Friday, motorists on Sunland Park Drive who want to enter I-10 Westbound will notice the westbound entrance ramp will be in the new and permanent configuration. Drivers will find themselves on the westbound CD lanes before being able to enter the main lanes of I-10.

The new roadway pattern, including finished and unfinished CD lanes, is illustrated below.


