On Sunday, August 11, I-10 East to be reduced to one lane until noon

I-10 East at Mesa

Daytime

Sunday, August 11

3 a.m. to noon

- I-10 East will be reduced to one lane between North Mesa Street (exit 11) and approximately mile marker 14.
- The North Mesa eastbound ramps will close.
- The North Mesa westbound-to-eastbound turnaround lanes will close.
- The eastbound CD lanes of I-10 will close completely at North Mesa Street (SH 20).
- The Resler flyover ramp will close.
- The Sunland Park flyover ramp will close.
- The Sunland Park eastbound exit ramp from the main lanes of I-10 (near Resler) will close.

Crews will be replacing toll signs. [Map 1]

All closures are subject to change or cancellation.

All closure times are approximate.

Exit and entrance ramps may close up to one hour prior to the start time of an I-10 closure.

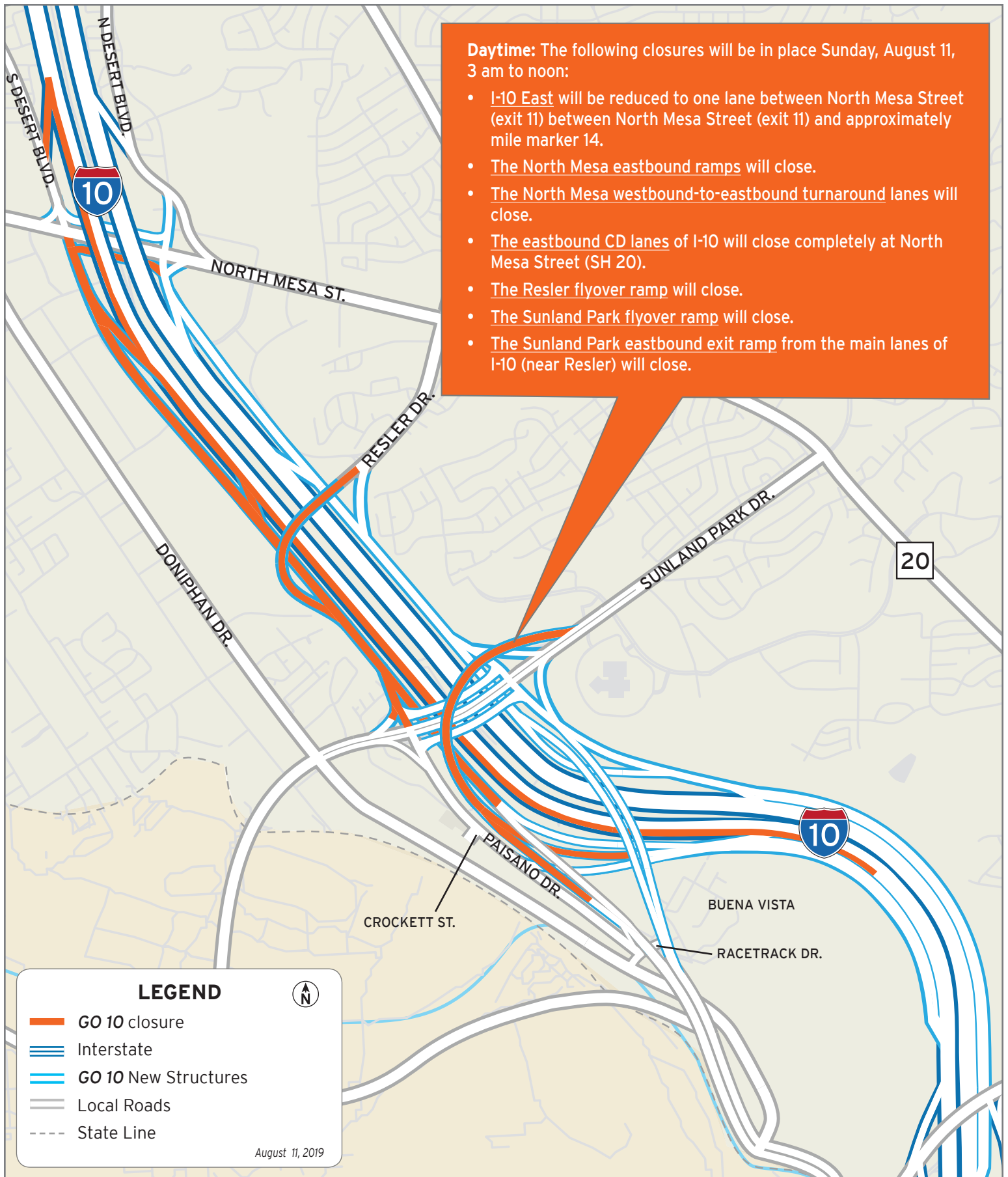
