I-10 West will close completely for one night near Sunland Park I-10 West will be down to one lane for several other nights

All closures are scheduled in avoidance of peak rush hours

I-10 Westbound

Overnight:

I-10 westbound will be completely closed for approximately 2,500 feet, between the Sunland Park Exit Ramp and the Paisano Entrance Ramp, for one night on Sunday, **June 12**, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning. Traffic should follow posted detour signs. This closure is necessary while crews re-stripe the road.

Overnight:

The left two lanes on I-10 westbound will be closed between the Buena Vista Bridge (aka the Bridge to Nowhere) and the Sunland Park Overpass for several nights as follows:

- > 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, **June 13**
- > 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday, **June 14**
- > 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Wednesday, **June 15**

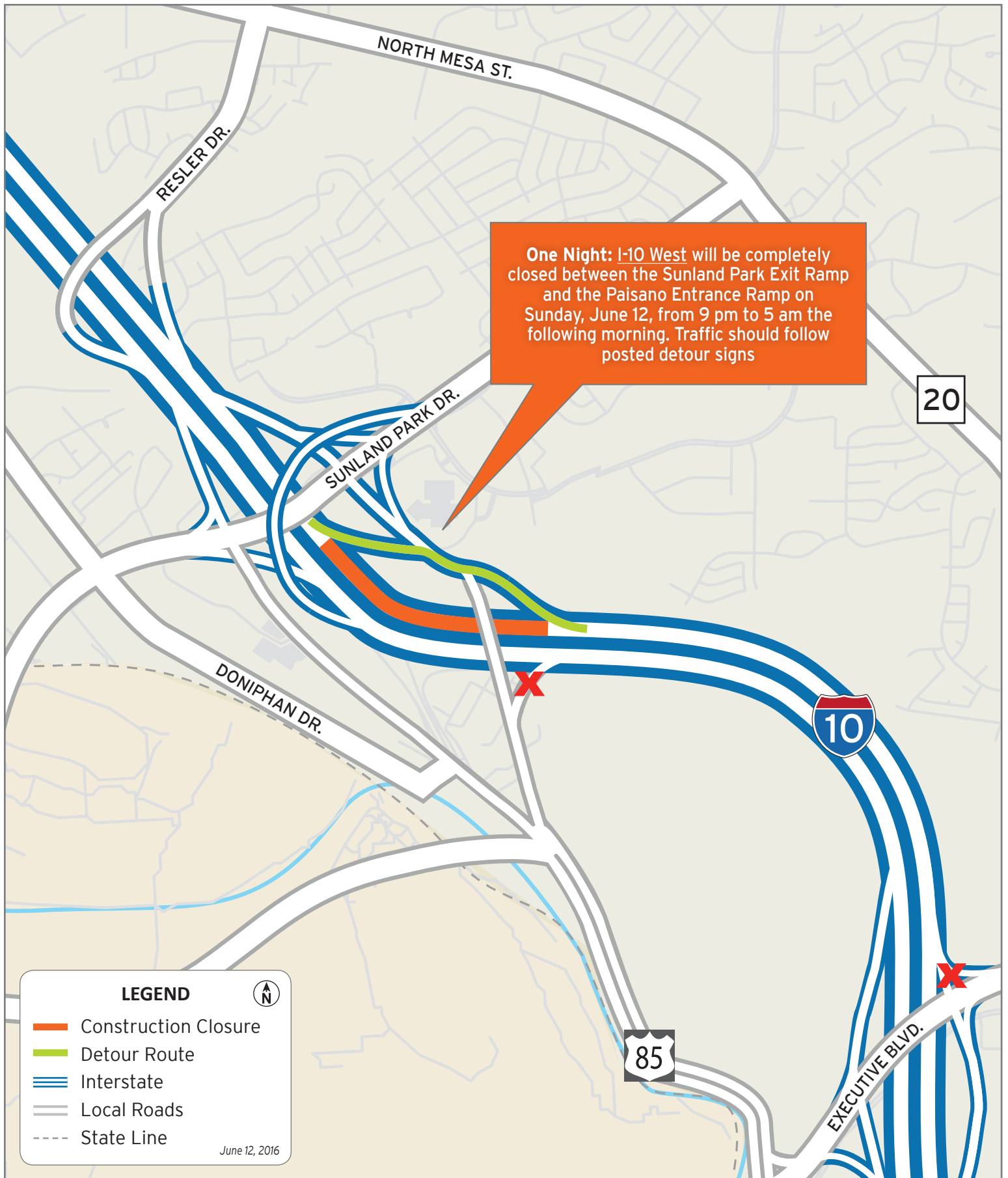

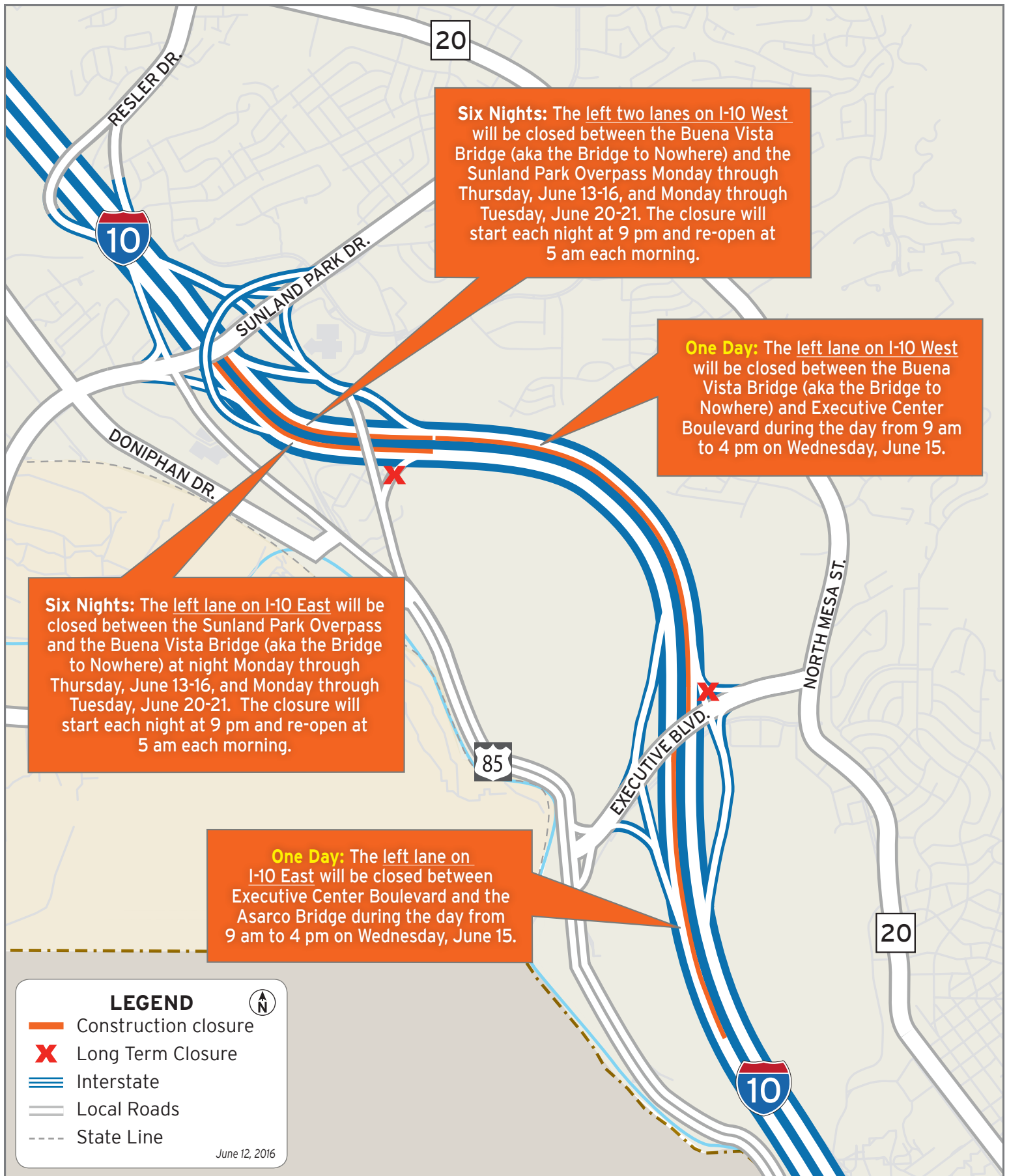
